Wake MK is located 43 miles north of London, and 24 miles from Luton (Airport)

Rules: The European Cable Wakeboard Tour is a coordinated series of competitions.

The competition will be carried out according to the rules of the EAME Cable

Wakeboard Council. The competition format will be free ride.

Facility: 10mm cableway 5 mast system, a special cableway for wakeboarding, 9.6

meters high

Prize money: € 2.000 in Open Category, € 500 in Junior Category

€ 3000 - €4000 Tour Overall Rankings

Categories: Open Women, Open Men - no age restriction

Junior Ladies, Junior Men - born 1989 and later

Masters Men - born 1977 or earlier

Entry: No entry minimum is required.

EAME federation members must have the Region EAME International Wakeboard License 2008. Riders from outside EAME must have a written permission or a license from their national federation to take part. It is up to the organizer to invite additional riders to take part, such as local riders or

snowboarders, local heroes, guests.

Homologation: The competition will be carried out homologated. Riders with EAME

Wakeboard License will get points for the EAME Cable Wakeboard Ranking

List 2008.

Directions to the Cable:



We're easy to find, whether you are local or coming by car, bus, or train.

By Car - From M1

Leave the M1 at J14 and head West towards Milton Keynes on the A509. After about 400m go over the first roundabout (3rd exit) keeping on the A509. Drive over the next roundabout (2nd exit) still on the A509. You will see the lake on your left. At the next roundabout (near Siemens) turn left onto the V10 Brickhill Street. At the next small roundabout turn left into the car park.

By Car - From A5

Leave the A5 at the A509 (Milton Keynes North and East), and head East towards the M1. Go straight over about 7 roundabouts until you

come to V10 Brickhill Street - Willen Lake will be signposted - take the last exit onto V10 Brickhill Street (by Siemens) heading south. At the next small roundabout turn left into the car park.

By Train

Go by train to British Rail Milton Keynes. We are a short (5 minute) taxi or bus ride away.

By Coach

Milton Keynes benefits from an excellent intercity coach service from most major UK towns. The coach park is just off the M1 J14 and is a short (2 minute) taxi ride from Willen Lake where WakeMK is based.

By Air

Nearest Airport is Luton
