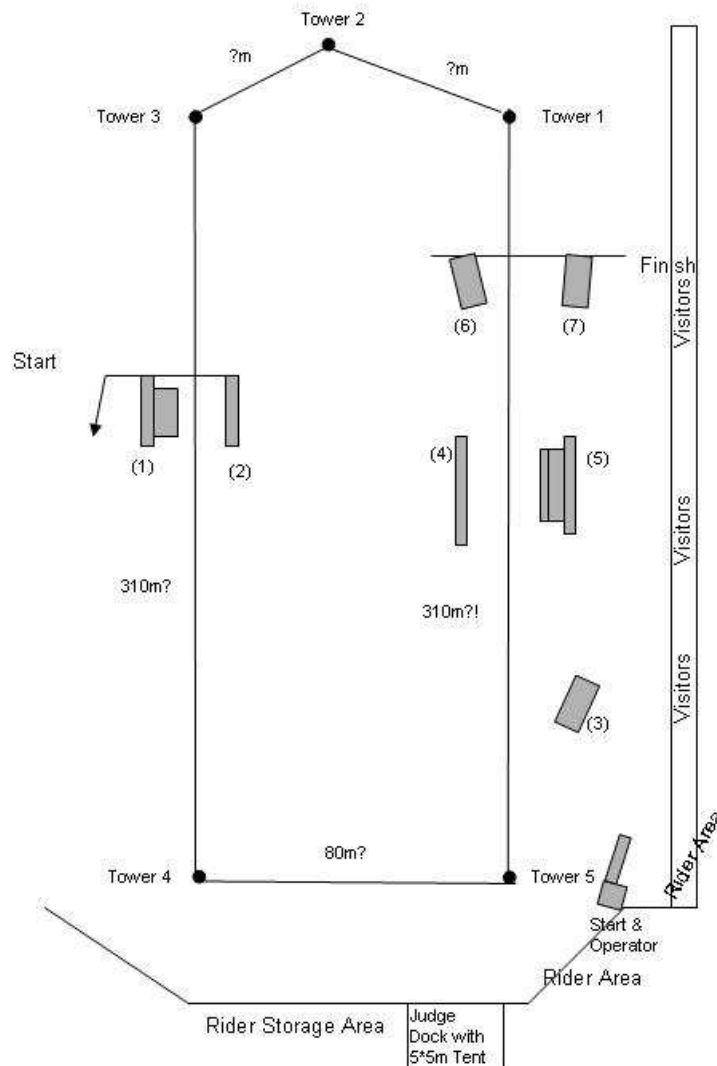

2. HOW TO GET TO NEUBRANDENBURG

2.1 By car:

From Berlin:

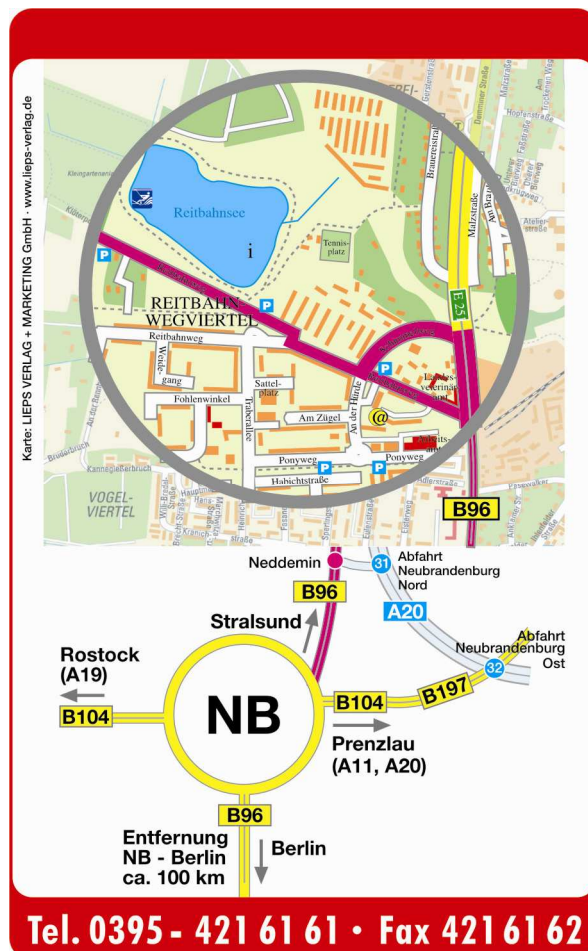
Take A11 toward Prenzlau >> take exit 5 “Kreuz Uckermark” to merge onto A20 >> take A20 toward Stralsund/Prenzlau >> take exit 31 “Neubrandenburg-Nord” and follow the same direction as it is described below.

Total distance: approx. 180 km (approx. time 2:00 hrs in a bus)

From Hamburg:

Take A1 toward Rostock/Lübeck >> take exit 3 “Kreuz Lübeck” to merge onto A20 toward Rostock/Lübeck >> take exit 31 “Neubrandenburg-Nord” towards Brunn/Friedland >> turn right at B96 (signs for Neddemin/Neubrandenburg) and pass the village Neddemin (still follow B96) >> take 3rd main intersection and turn right into „Reitbahnwegviertel“ >> follow the signs to Reitbahnsee

Total distance: approx. 320 km (approx. time 3:15 hrs)



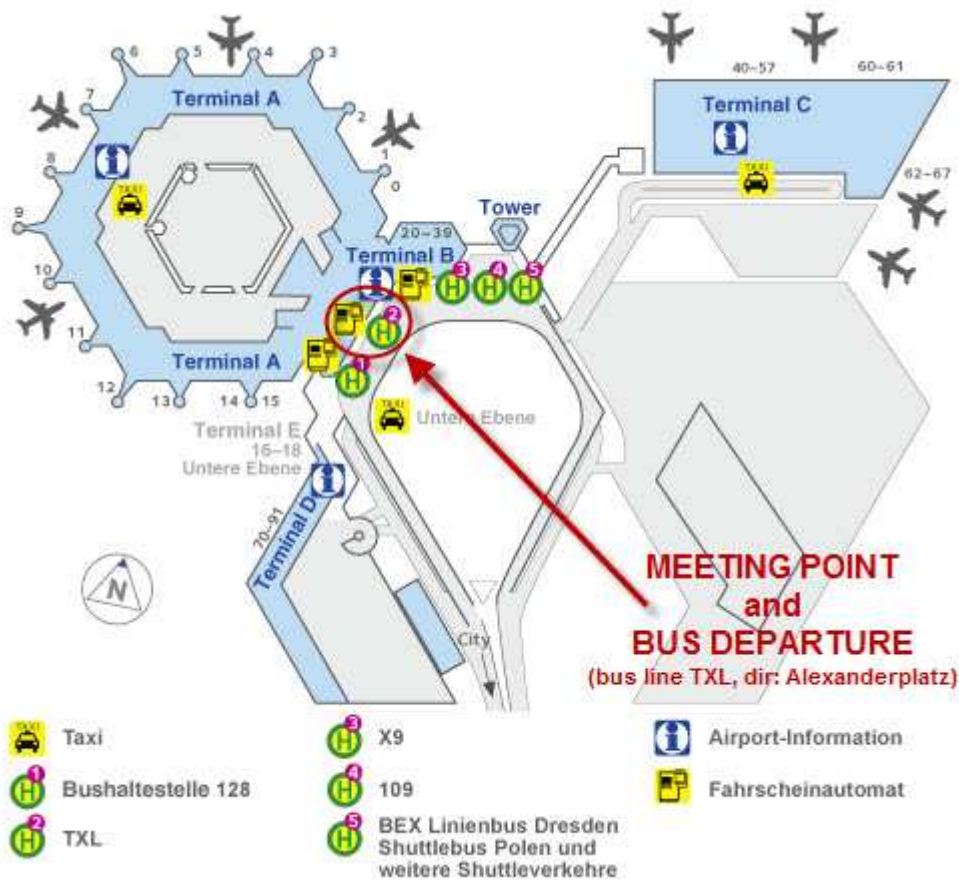

2.2 By Plane:

Pls note that Berlin has two airports, your destination Airport is **Berlin TEGEL (TXL)**. Most International and domestic flights will arrive here. **DO NOT fly into Berlin-Schoenefeld (SXF)** if you want to use our shuttle service etc, as we only provide a guided train shuttleservice back and forth from Tegel. If you arrive at the wrong airport it might take you up to 90 minutes to get from Berlin-Schoenefeld to Berlin-Tegel.

2.3 Transportation from/to airport Berlin TEGEL:

Due to an obvious lack of need we have cancelled our plans of a bus shuttle. If you need help or a guide, please let us know in advance - we do offer an train escort service, which costs **30 Euros (including the ticket)**.

Upon your arrival in TEGEL, meet us at our Meeting Point (near Information Desk, between terminals A and B). Here you'll be equipped with all the information you need.

Please have cash at hand, and don't forget to let us know **before** arrival. If you are landing in Schönefeld (SFX), you have to make it to Berlin Central Station or the airport Berlin-Tegel (TXL) on your own. Sounds dangerously, but it isn't.

PLEASE note:

We will **ONLY** implement that form of guided service from the Airport Berlin TEGEL (TXL)! Please make sure that all your flights go into that airport. Should you fly into Berlin Schoenefeld (SFX) you have to travel on your own expenses either to the meetingpoint at the airport Berlin TEGEL or directly to Neubrandenburg.

Futhermore we will implement that service **ONLY from Sunday (11th July) until Tuesday (13th July)**. Please note the exact shuttle times. If you should arrive sooner or later you must also travel to the venue in Neubrandenburg on your own expenses.

Please make sure:

- That we know when you arrive
- That we know how large your travelling party is (including family & friends) **BEFORE** you arrive
- You have sufficient Euro funds for transfer tickets and inscription fees etc. at hand

To secure a smooth and uncomplicated registration process, please read this carefully.

Your date of registration is on monday, July 12th, and tuesday, July 13th, from 10 am – 08 pm. Following your arrival at the competition venue, please make sure you go and see the **registration counter** first. Please present your **ID/passport**, your **entry form**, and the **attached disclaimer**. In case you haven't wired the registration fee to NICE Productions already, registration is going to collect the fee, including late fee fine. In case you're travelling with "Family & Friends", this is where their tickets are paid as well.

Every contestant has to collect a lycra with his number upon registration. Lycras are given out against a 30 Euro deposit, receipt included.
