- Entry fee contains official training Friday 8:00 – 10:00 and Saturday 8:00 – 9:00 refreshment for riders and celebration party

4. Categories

- Categories are strictly divided by age of riders, only Open category is free
- It's necessary to have at least 3 riders for opening category. When category has fewer Riders, it will not be open and category will be combined with other category.
- Riders are divided to categories by the age they will have in year 2016.
- Double starts are not allowed (only wakeboard and wakeskate is allowed but rider has to pay double entry fee).
- All Riders have to be registered in IWWF.
- Open categories:
 - U15 – girls and boys born in 2001 or later
 - U19 - girls and boys born in 1997 or later
 - OPEN women and men OPEN is without age limitation
 - O30 - women and men born in 1986 or earlier
 - Wakeskate competition is without age limitation

8. Registration

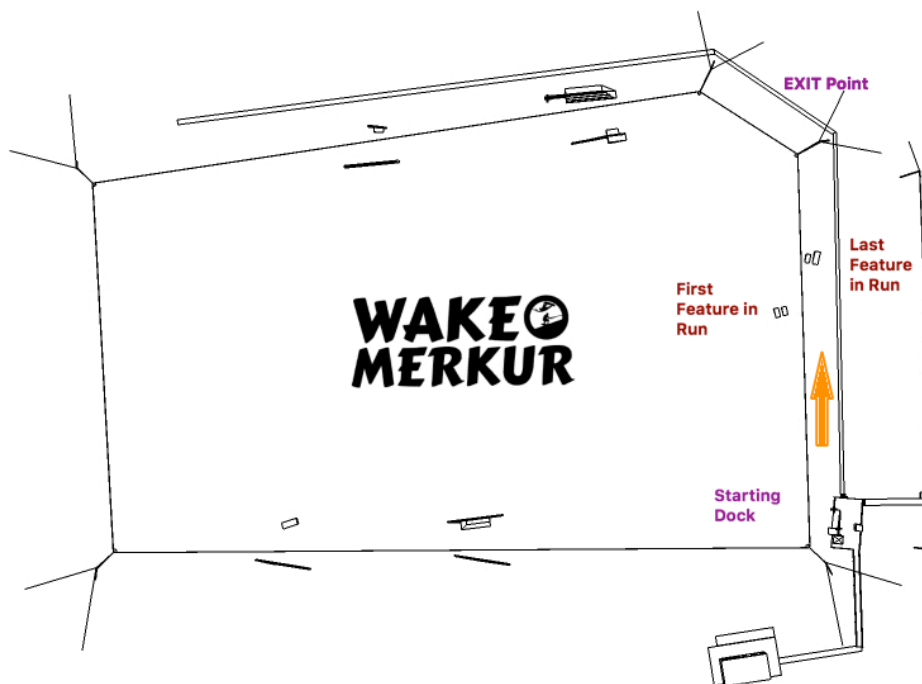
- Riders have to register in Registration office in Competition site

11. Running Course

- Competition running course will start with first feature
- Competitors will go thru all cable park
- Last counted trick will be performed on first left or right kicker after starting dock
- After this trick performance competitors have to leave cable after next pylon (EXIT point)
- If rider will continue to another course without leaving in EXIT point, it can be classified by disqualification
- Competition will be judged 50:50 by air tricks and features
- All riders have to wear helmet and vest during all competition rides, official training included; break of this rule will be classified by disqualification

12. Safety rules during competition

- All Riders participate the competition on their own risk. Their agreement is confirmed by signing the registration form.
- Organizer is not responsible for any damages, harms or injuries of Riders, technical crew, judges neither other persons.
- All Riders are fully responsible for their behavior during the competition and additional program.
- By participating in the race Riders shall waive any claim for damages or for any other losses incurred or damage caused directly or indirectly during the race.
- For damage caused to third parties, the organizer is responsible only to the extent of his responsibility like organizer.
- Competitors younger than 18 years old are required during training and registration to submit the written consent of parents or legal guardians to participate in the race and in training.
- Competitors have to wear during the competition and official training vests and helmets, even when not using obstacles.
