It's a pleasure for us to invite you to the **NATIONAL & INTERNATIONAL Cable Wakeboard & Wakeskate JUDGE SEMINAR**, to be held from 13 &14 October 2016 at The Spin Cablepark in Froidchapelle, Belgium. 1. How to get to The Spin Cablepark

The Spin Cablepark is located at the « lacs de l'Eau d'Heure », the biggest lake group in wallonia, in the province of 'Hainaut'.

By car; GPS entry "16, rue Crossart" 6440 Froidchapelle

Public transportation:

By train: final destination "Walcourt" at 5 kilometer from the spin. After that, take the shuttle lake http://www.lacsdeleaudheure.be/leh-fr/menu-de-droite/venir-aux-lacs/mobilacs.html?langue=fr

By plane: Many international flights, including Ryan Air, land in Brussels zaventem or Brussel south (Charleroi). From there you can take the train towards Charleroi and Walcourt.

2. Before traveling to Belgium

- **2.1 Visa**: Belgium is part of the Schengen Area so most of the European travellers don't need a visa for short stays. Please check your specific country or get information at your travel agencies or consulate.
- **2.2 Identity proof**: Please make sure that you are coming with a valid ID document stating date of birth and nationality.
- **2.3 Local currency**: The Belgian currency is Euro (€).

Established credit cards (like Visa and Mastercard) are accepted in most places. You can also use them to draw cash at ATMs.

2.4 Time difference : Knokke-Heist is on Central European Time (CET)

For example, 00:00 in Central Europe is 00:00 in Froidchapelle and 23:00 in London

2.5 General information: Main electricity: 220 Volt, use an Euro plug or an universal adapter.

2.6 Emergency telephone numbers:

- 100: Hospital-based Ambulance (SAMU)
- +32: International prefix for France

Belgian mobile phone network is connected to the European GSM standards. Your national mobile phone will connect with the following main networks: Mobistar, Proximus, ...

4. Conditions

The Judge seminar will be carried out according to the CWWC World Rules 2016. A full copy of the rules is online available at: www.cablewakeboard.net (direct link here)

The seminar will be open to all registrants above 10 years who are speaking proper English. Until the Age of 16 you can only get 1STAR. To become 2 STAR you have to be over 16. 3STAR Level and higher you can get by the Age of 18 years and older.

How it works?

The International Waterski and Wakeboard Federation (IWWF) was founded in 1946. IWWF is recognized by the International Olympic Committee (IOC) as official partner since 1967. Wakeboarding is part of the World Games (Non Olympic Games patronized by IOC) since 2005. Since 2011 Wakeboard is on the Shortlist for addition to the Olympic Games 2020!

The IWWF is the world leader in waterskiing and wakeboarding with more than 90 member nations, hundreds of clubs and thousands of members. Together with agencies and local federations, the IWWF organizes Nationals Championships, European and World Championships, the IWWF World Cup and World Trophy, and hundreds of internationals competitions all over the world.

The IWWF Cable Wakeboard World Council (CWWC) is a rider formed, voluntary non-profit working council. CWWC organizes and promotes wakeboard, helping organizers to create and run competitions, developing the Cable Wakeboard World Rules, formats, judging criteria's and educating judges. The CWWC is recognised for running the sport part of events under fair conditions for all riders, fair and fast judging, perfect "just in time" timetables, live & online results,

5. Registration

You need to register for the seminar at www.cablewakeboard.net

If this is your first international event, first go to 'registration' and create a profile. Once you have a profile, 'login' and go to 'My competition' where you can join the seminar.

All participants should be members of their respective country's IWWF affiliated Federation with a valid 'Official/Competitor' wakeboard license.

A detailed timetable will be provided later to all registrants. The seminar will start at 9h on Thursday, October 13th and end on Friday October 14th latest at 18h.

The deadline to join the seminar is **Monday Night, 10th October**. However, we advise everyone to book the accommodation as soon as possible because of the limited availability.

The seminar takes 2 days (Thursday & Friday) On Saturday there will be a 2 Star International competition where you can already gain experience and help out.
