All riders and officials have to send the scan of their passports to office@cablewakeboard.net 2017 to get an invitation for Chinese visa.

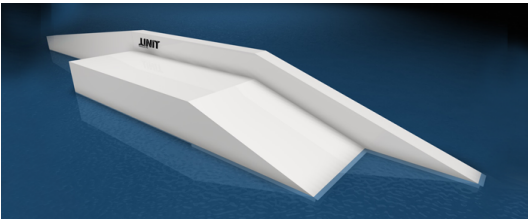
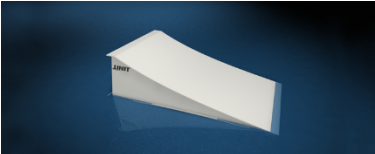
