Please ask counter that you need to go "Hotel Grand Pacific Le Daiba" at ODAIBA area. It will cost ¥2,700/person.

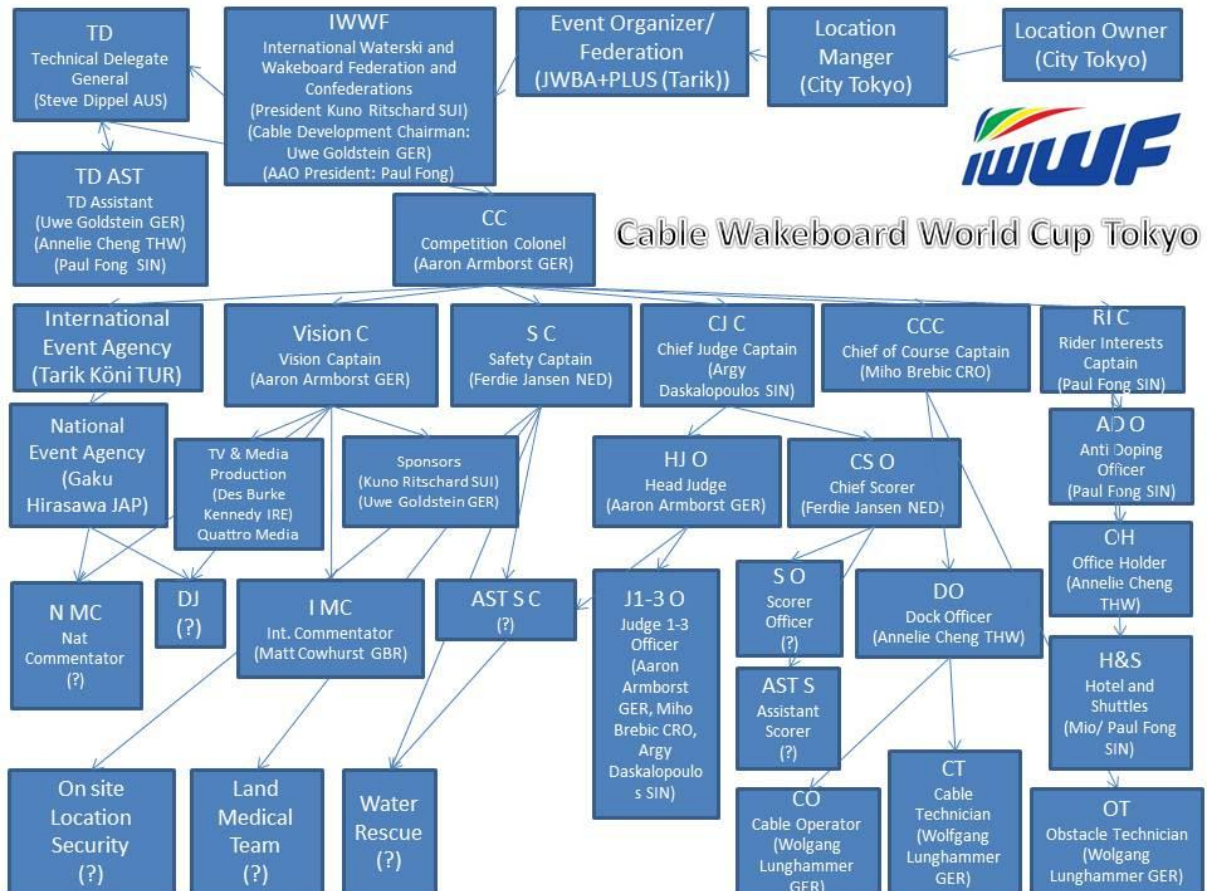
Free Catering from 31th

Official Plan

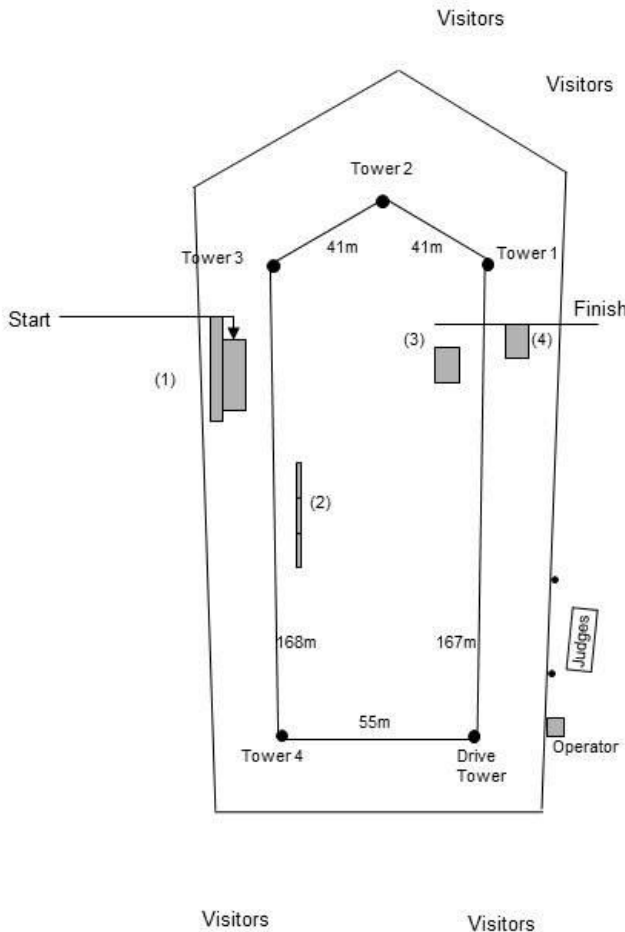




Obstacle Plan

Obstacles	
1)	Rixen Funbox 17,70
2)	Rixen Table 24m
3)	Rixen Kicker 1,10m
4)	Rixen Kicker 1,30m

Notes:

- It will be possible to do 3 Obstacles and 3-5 Inverts
 - Straights are very short!
- You have to be very fast to come from the Funbox to the Table
- Could be possible that you have to "Ollie On" the Table (40-50cm)
- Invert before Comer 4 will be very hard because of very less time
- Straight before the Engine Tower is also very short!
