

### 4 HOW TO GET TO TELEMARK/ SAUHERAD

### 4.1 By air

Nearest airport is:

Torp, Sandefjord, 100 km (KLM, NORWEGIAN, WIDERØE, WIZZAIR, RYANAIR) Other airports:

Gardermoen, Oslo 160 km

Train station:

Nordagutu, 3 km, trains from Oslo

The Organizer will provide a shuttle service from the Airport to Norsjø Ferieland and to the Official Hotel. To be more flexible you can also rent a car at the airport.

### **4.2** By car

From Oslo:

Follow E-18 to Drammen, take right on E-134 to Notodden, take left on RV - 360 to Akkerhaugen (App. 25 km from Notodden, take left and follow signs for Norsjø Ferieland)

#### From Kristiansand:

Follow E-18 to Porsgrunn, RV 36 to Seljord, in Gvarv take right on RV 360 to Akkerhaugen. (App5 km from Gvarv, take right and follow signs for Norsjø Ferieland.



















### From Haugesund:

Follow E-134 to Seljord, take right on RV 36 to Skien/Porsgrunn. in Gvarv take right on RV 360 to Akkerhaugen. (App5 km from Gvarv, take right and follow signs for Norsjø Ferieland.

### 5.2 Identity card/passport

For the ANTI DOPING Controlls you need to have a **passport** valid for at least 6 months. An identity card is not enough.

All riders have to sign a liability form. For riders under 18 years old, their parents have to sign it as well. Team Captains must present all the liability forms to the IWWF Officials at registration.

### 6 ACCOMMODATION

There are limited rental beds close to the cable park. The organizer want to accommodate the riders in and around Norsjø Ferieland, to make the World Championships 2014 as compact and green as possible.

Therefore, booking of accommodation at Norsjø Ferieland/Norsjø Hotel has to be done through the National Federations, <u>and the federations only</u>, in the period from November 1<sup>st</sup> 2013 to February 28<sup>th</sup> 2014.

### Local Camping Park Rules (FOR EVERYBODY AND ALL AGES)

Everybody has to be quiet after midnight. Whoever wants to sleep should be able to. No consumption of alcohol outside the cabins or hotel rooms. It is ONLY allowed inside your accommodation or in designated areas, such as the restaurant and certain marked areas. There are inspections every day for damages in cabins. Because of the general political situation and this kind of event, the Police will be around all the time to make everything as safe as possible. In Norway, there is 0 tolerance for bad behavior and people who drink too much alcohol.

The Location is owned by the Family Lindheim. The very friendly and fair BOSS is Torstein Lindheim. You will met him sooner or later. With his family and partners, he invested much love in this park and they all welcome you for a nice time in this wonderfull place.



















### 6.1 Norsjø Ferieland

Placed at the World Championships venue. Cabins, mobile homes, areas for private tents.

### 6.1.1 Cabin 6-7 persons (shower and toilet)

10 fully equipped cabins each with 2 bedrooms, shower and WC, living room with small kitchen area. Sleeps up to 8 guests.

Price Option 1: € 2450 per week (10.08-17.08), breakfast incl. Cleaning twice a week. Price Option 2: Price: € 190 per night. Breakfast not included. Cleaning by departure.



### Description of cabin:

- o 2 bedrooms (family bunkerbeds with a maximum of 3 persons in each bedroom).
- o 2 persons might sleep on the sofa in the living room
- o Bathroom with shower and toilet
- o Livingroom with kitchen. Equipment for 8 persons.
- o Dishwasher
- o Private balcony with table and chairs.

















### 6.1.2 Cabin 4 persons (shower and toilet)

8 fully equipped cabins each with 1 bedroom, shower and WC, living room with small kitchen area. Sleeps up to 6 guests.

Price Option 1: € 1800 per week, breakfast incl. Cleaning twice a week.

Price Option 2: € 165 per night. Breakfast not included. Cleaning by departure.

### 6.1.3 Cabin 4 persons (with toilet/shower in separate building)

10 fully equipped cabins each with 1 bedroom, WC, living room with small kitchen area. Sleeps up to 4 guests.

Price Option 1: € 1550 per week, breakfast incl. Cleaning twice a week.

Price Option 2: € 140 per night. Breakfast not included. Cleaning by departure.



### Description of cabin:

- o 1 bedroom (2 bunkerbeds for 4 persons).
- Toilet and shower short walking distance to restroom facilities.
- o Livingroom with kitchen. Equipment for 4 persons.
- o Private balcony with table and chairs.

















### 6.1.4 Mobile homes 4 persons (toilet/shower in separate building)

At Norsjø Ferieland there will be mobile homes for rent. They normally fit for 4 persons, but might also be for 6.

Price Option 1: € 1550 per week, breakfast incl. (4 persons). Extra beds: € 375 per week. Cleaning twice a week.

Price Option 2: € 140 per night. Breakfast not included. Cleaning by departure.



### 6.1.5 Private tents/mobile homes/motorhomes

At Norsjø Ferieland there is possible to bring your own tent/mobile home. Restroom facilities with toilet and shower is available in walking distance. Prices Option 1: per week, with breakfast included:

Own tent: € 150 per person.

Own mobile home/motorhome with el-power: € 285 per unit.

Price Option 2: Breakfast not included.

Price tent: € 12 per night per person. Breakfast not included.
Price mobile homes/motorhomes: € 30 per night with el-power.



















### 6.2 Norsjø Hotel 6.2.1 Norsjø Hotel

A charming, cosy hotel, overlooking the picturesque lake Norsjø, where the M/S "Telemarken" calls daily on her way to and from the locks in the Telemark Channel from June to August, and also overlooking the World Championships-arena Norsjø Cable Park.

Norsjø offers personal service and a warm atmosphere. 54 bedrooms, of which several are fitted for families.

Distance to the Cable Park: 1 km

Price Option 1: double room: € 1050 per week (10.08-17.08), breakfast incl.

Price Option 2: double room: € 140 per night, breakfast included.



### 6.2.2 Dalheim apartments "Fully Booked"

5 minutes walk from Norsjø Ferieland there is 6 flats for rent, 2 for 2-3 persons, 2 for 4 persons and 2 for 6 persons. The apartments are fully equipped.

Prices Option 1: with breakfast included per week:

2-3 persons: € 1150, 4 persons: € 1650, 6 persons € 2050.

Prices Option 2: Breakfast not included. Cleaning by departure.

2-3 persons: € 155 per night. 4 persons: € 165 per night. 6 persons: € 190 per night.

Every morning a Breakfast is prepared for Riders and Officials who are staying at the Cablepark Accomodations

### 7 FAMILY, FRIENDS

Family & Friends package that include lunch and dinner at site for 7 days (Sunday-Saturday) will cost **120 € per person**. The fee includes soft drinks to every meal. Organizer will offer a special Prize for the entrance to the party and rock festival.

### **8 ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

### 8.1 Nomination

It is the sole responsibility of IWWF-affiliated National Federations to select and enter their riders.

Please have the new Entry Requirements in mind: CWWC Rulebook §3.2 **MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS AS OF YEAR 2014:** For Junior, Open and Masters 800 points, and for Boys, Girls and Veterans 400 points on the current CWWC Ranking list at the time when the competition starts. Additionally, each Federation can enter max. 2 riders per gender per category with no minimum requirements.

Please have in mind that a rider can add points from different categories to get the minimum requirement together. i.E.: a boy could compete in 4 STAR Events in Junior Categories and at his nationals in Boy Category. He can add the archieved points and when he has minimum 400 he can start in boys category or when he have more than 800 he could start in juniors. Same with Masters and Veterans points. Points from Wakeboard and Wakeskate could not be added.

### 8.2 Conditions

The Cable Wakeboard and Wakeskate World Championships will be carried out according to the IWWF Cable Wakeboard World Council rules.

### 8.3 Safety

Please note that all riders have to wear helmet and an approved life vest. All participants ride/compete at their own risk.



















### 8.4 Categories Wakeboard and Wakeskate 2014

**Wakeboard** 

Boys and Girls Your year of birth must be 1999, 2000 or 2001.

Because of a national rule, Boys and Girls born in

2002 or later are not allowed to start!

Junior Men/Ladies Your year of birth must be 1995 or later.

Open Men/Ladies No age restriction.

Masters Men/Ladies Your year of birth must be 1983 or before. Veterans Men/Ladies Your year of birth must be 1973 or before

**Wakeskate** 

Junior Men/Ladies Your year of birth must be 1995 or later.

Open Men/Ladies No age restriction

Riders born in 2002 and after are not allowed to compete on international level in any category or competition.

#### 8.5 License

All riders must be members of their respective country's IWWF affiliated federation. All entrants must have the IWWF International Wakeboard Licence.

#### How it works:

IWWF has a network of +90 national federations. Only IWWF-affiliated national federations can submit entry forms for the World Championships. By entering riders for the World Championships, national federations certify that their respective riders are in possession of a wakeboard licence and a valid insurance (which provides international coverage)

Each national federation selects its team and decides on allowing the individual entries. If your are not sure how it works in your country og how to locate your respective National Federation, please contact us and we will provide information to you.

**Exceptions:** Riders from countries without a national wakeboard/wakeski federation affiliated to the IWWF, will be permitted to register to compete in















the IWWF World Championships, subject to approval from the IWWF. Please contact us for more information.

### 8.6 Entry fee Wakeboard and Wakeskate

Riders starting in both wakeboard and wakeskate category will pay an additional entry fee for second category of  $50 \\in / 450 kr$  for Open and older and  $30 \\in / 250 kr$  for Juniors and younger.

Please kindly note that your entry fee includes lunch, dinner and soft drinks from the day of the Official training till Saturday. Other drinks and food are not included, but can be purchased at the cable park. Entry fee also includes free entry to the Rock Festival "Kartfestivalen".

### 8.7 Riders Registration

Before a Federation can approve a rider, every rider has to register at <a href="https://www.cablewakeboard.net">www.cablewakeboard.net</a> and has to join the competition.

After a rider joins the Competition the Federations has to login at <a href="http://myzone.cablewakeboard.net/en/116/?sub=7&comp=598">http://myzone.cablewakeboard.net/en/116/?sub=7&comp=598</a> to approve the Rider! Federations can also do there the Intetions to Enter to give an estimate how many riders they will send!

Registration Check List (per rider) what have to be checked by the teamcaptain before registration:

- 1. Completed all **profile fields** (to check please click on the rider link on the entry form)
- 2. A **profile picture** in the first slot. (first picture will be displayed on the Monitors)
- 3. Completed liability form. <u>U18</u> or <u>Adult</u> (if possible signed by the Parents)
- 4. Completed <u>anti-doping agreement</u> (if possible signed by the Parents)
- 5. Valid passport showing nationality to prove that the rider is eligible to compete for your team (ID Card is not enough)
- 6. Vegetarian?
- 7. You want to be Rider Representative?!

Once all your riders have completed the above steps the team Captain should report to registration with all passports, forms and proof of payment to complete registration. During the registration the Federation Team Captain will receive the official Rider's Bib. Please note that you have to pay a deposit of 30,- € for your Riders Bib.

Currencies accepted at registration are Krone, Euros & US Dollars!

### RIDERS' REPRESENTATIVE ELECTION

This is the second time for the Cable Wakeboard World Council to officially elect the Rides' representative.

The mission of the riders' representative is to represent the views of the riders and make their voice heard within the Wakeboard Council. This rider sits also in the IWWF Athletes Commission where all diciplines are combinedd. Two Members of this Commission are sitting also as representatives on the IWWF Executive Board to decide everything in IWWF.

The term of the riders' representative is until the next World Champs in two years.

### **Procedure**

The election of the riders' representative will take place during the riders meeting. Only the riders competing at these World Championships and present at the riders meeting have the right to vote.

Any rider wishing to stand for the position will nominate him/herself latest at the time of registration on site.

The nominees must:

- be over the age of 18
- have competed in the Open finals of at least two titled events in the past 4 years















 be present at the World Champs at the time of registrations and the riders meeting, but not necessarily as a competitor

After the registrations are closed, the complete list of nominees will be published on info boards at the cable, in the official hotel and at <a href="mailto:cable-wakeboard.net">cable-wakeboard.net</a>.

The ballot paper will be handed out to all riders participating at the Championships and the riders meeting and must be submitted by the end of the riders' meeting to the ballot box.

The results will be announced at the Opening Ceremony.

If you wish to stand for the election, don't wait until deadline! Submit your nomination now to CWWC at <a href="mailto:cwwc@cablewakeboard.net">cwwc@cablewakeboard.net</a>, as soon as we confirm your eligibility, you can start your campaign:)

### Official team training & rental hours for teams

Official training for teams is on Sunday 10th and Monday 11th August. As always, each country will have the training times calculated by number of riders. The final schedule by country will be published on Saturday, 9<sup>th</sup> in the evening (after the registrations are done).

Federations can book rental hours for teams online for the three days before Thursday, Friday, Saturday, 7-9<sup>th</sup> August from 8 to 12 and 16 to 20 hours. For rental hours we will follow these rules:

- Each country has 6 credits to book 6 different time frames.
- Each time frame is 30 minutes and has no limit of entries.
- You can use all 6 credits on the first day, but only 4 on the second and 2 on the last.
- The deadline for booking is 13 hours before the first time frame of the next day start.
- Bookins can be only made by the Federations with the Federation Login on <a href="http://myzone.cablewakeboard.net/en/116/?sub=7&comp=598">http://myzone.cablewakeboard.net/en/116/?sub=7&comp=598</a>
- You can only book with your full team of entered riders.
- Price for 30 minutes is 75 €, divided by number of riders in each time frame and charged to Federations.
- We kindly ask you to make the payment at the registration on site for your number of riders and time used.

### 8.8 Doping control

According to the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules, drug controls will be conducted during this competition. By entering this competition all riders agree to be subject to doping control. Information about the IWWF Anti-Doping program can be found at

### 8.9 Official Practice Day

The official practice day for Wakeboard will be Sunday  $10^{\rm th}$  and for Wakeskate Monday  $11^{\rm th}$  August. Wakeskate training will be allocated by Age category and after announcement. Wakeboard trainings will be allocated per nation/team and after announcement.

Training on the official practice day is included in the entry fees.


