1. Location

Since 1976 the „Alstervergnügen“ takes place annually: More than 1 Million spectators promenade across the “Binnenalster”. Since 2010 the Wake-Masters have pioneered this unique location for wakeboarding and we are proud to offer in 2014 for the first time an international competition.

by plane: Hamburg Airport (HAM)
 the airport is well connected with S-Bah (Underground) S-1 and U-1 towards “Dammtorbahnhof” wich is in 5 minutes walking distance to our venue:

by railway
 don’t leave your train at central station – just continue to Dammtorbahnhof (wich is 2 Minutes across the bridge direction “Altona”)

by car
 parking space is very limited – so use car parks close to “neuer Jungfernstieg” or try to catch something at “Außenalster”

5. Registration

Deadline for the registration is 23.08.2014, 8 pm (CET).

The earlier you register, the sooner we can provide you with a detailed timetable and use this information for communication and promotional purposes. Latest registration and inscription will be at the venue on August 28th 10 am – 1 pm. Registration after Saturday the 23rd August will occur a 10 Euros late fee on top of the entry fee.

5.1 Entry fee:

Open Wakeboard & Open Wakeskate **75,00 Euro / person**

The entry fee must be paid until one week prior the competition, otherwise the participant needs to pay a late fee of 10,00 EURO.

Deadline for the registration is **23.08.2014 / 8 pm**. After that deadline the fee will increase to **85,00 EURO/ person**. Even if the entry fee is paid in time please bring a copy/print out of the payment for the registration at the event side. If the participant cannot attend the event, but paid already the entry fee, he/she needs to get in contact immediately with the tour manager and send a doctor's note within one week to the organization to get the entry fee back.

9. License required

All riders should be members of their respective country's IWWF affiliated federation with a valid international wakeboard license.

If you are not sure how it works in your country, how to find the nearest club or the federation contact, please contact us and we'll provide information for you.

Exceptions: Riders from countries that don't have a Wakeboard/Waterski Federation affiliated to IWWF can register for the competition. If this is the case please contact us and we'll help you to arrange the insurance policy and a permission for individual entry.

10. Athletes Registration

On-site registration will be on Friday, 28th August from 10 am – 1 pm local time. Please bring along your passport or ID in order to identify yourself. Registration on Friday after 1 pm and on Saturday are not possible.

11. Doping control

In accordance with the IWWF Anti-Doping Policy, random drug testing may be conducted on any of the competition days. All riders must have their passports available during the competition. Please note, if you are randomly chosen for drug testing, and fail to identify yourself with your passport, or fail to take the test for any other reason, it will result with an immediate disqualification.
