- Rixen 4 mast system, length: 832 meters, height: 11 meters,
- The cables height was increased in 2010 and has a very good pull now.
- Modified motor in 2014.

- Shape Obstacles Roof-Elbow-Pipe inside (TBC)
- Shape Obstacles Pipe-Doublerooft with Wall outside
- Kicker small inside
- Kicker big outside

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

### CATEGORIES

#### Wakeboard:

Junior Ladies/ Junior Men: 1995 or later  
Open Ladies / Open Men: Open class, no age restrictions  
Masters: 1983 or before

#### Wakeskate:

Open Ladies / Open Men: Open class, no age restrictions

### QUALIFICATION

The competition is open for national and international athletes. All riders should be current member of their respective country's IWWF affiliated Federation. In addition, entrants from E&A should have the E&A International Wakeboard License (National Federations register their riders license online).

### ENTRY FEE

Includes: 2 Meals on site (Friday dinner & Saturday Lunch), Official T-Shirt and Aftershow-Party-Ticket.

The organiser charges an entry fee of 75€ per rider and category. To be eligible to participate, the fee must have arrived prior to July 3rd at 8pm. Riders that have not completed registration in time and have not payed the entry fee will not have a guaranteed spot on the roster. Any registration past this date will be considered a late registration that increases the fee to 110€.

Riders that have not completed registration in time and have not payed the entry fee will not have a guaranteed spot on the roster.

You have to pay the Entry fee in cash and complete all required registration paperwork on site before the event begins.

Riders that miss the starting time of their run with out a plausible reason will not receive a refund of any kind. Competitors that have registered for [www.cablewakeboard.net](http://www.cablewakeboard.net) and are a no show, will be charged the entry fee.

## LYCRA

Every participant will receive a lycra at the starting dock and is required to return it to the jacket marshall after his or her run. For jerseys that are not returned a fee of 30€ per lycra will be charged.

## HOW TO GET THERE

You need to have a current identity card if you are in the European Community. Otherwise you need a passport.

## PUBLIC TRANSPORT

If you use the public transport you best go by train to the main stations in the city center. Then take the Underground U2 and leave the train at Station "Donaustadtbrücke". Use the back end exit of the station. Then turn right and after 300 Meter you reach the cable park.

## BY CAR

Coming from west, south and east use the A23 city highway. Exit "Ölhafen Lobau".

Coming from the north use the A22 highway. Also take the Exit "Ölhafen Lobau".

Turn left at the first traffic light and follow the street back till you see the signs for "WakeUp" or Underground. For parking use the park & ride garage on the right hand side. For € 3,- you can stay there the whole day! Note: You need to buy a "Vignette" when you hit the border. The price for 10 days is € 8,30,-  
Speedlimits: city: 50 km/h, country road: 100 km/h, highway: 130 km/h

## BY PLANE

"Vienna Schwechat international airport" is about 15 minutes away from the cable park. You can either use the CAT (city airport train) and then change to the underground or send us an email with your flight details to [office@wakecontrol.at](mailto:office@wakecontrol.at) till July 1st, 2014.

Then we will try to arrange pick up service in groups.

As an alternative you can fly to Bratislava (Slovakia). But from there is no pick up service possible.

## LIABILITY

The organizer does not take over adhesion for persons -, special or financial damages opposite fighters, arbitrators, official ones, aids or third persons. All fighters participate in each relationship on own danger, even if they engage themselves outside of the match, e.g. in the master program. With the participation the runners do without any demands of requirements from all cases of damage, which result directly or indirectly from the meeting. All participants must be liability-insured accident - and/or. The requirements of the condition and the safety precautions of the match distances depend on the valid in each case regulations of the international water ski federation (IWSF) region E&A, the national water ski federation (OEWSV), the valid in each case regulation and delivering mode of the OEWSV and the valid in each case agreement (product requirement specifications) between the organizing committee (OK ONE) and the OEWSV, whereby the arrangements of the respective arbitrator are determining. Each participant commits itself to speak own objections the arbitrator. With his start the fighter gives to recognize that the given condition of the match distance and existing safety precautions are suitable as and are sufficiently recognized. An adhesion for a certain condition of the match distance or certain safety precautions, going beyond that, does not take over the organizer. All athletes get the adhesion explanation during the registration suburb to the signature submitted.
