Description of the route to the Cablepark:

By car

from the North East (Milano-Venezia):

Motorway A4, at the pay station follow "Tangenziale Est" direction "Aeroporto Linate". Exit "Aeroporto Linate" follow for about 3 km the street always straight and follow indication "Idroscalo"; when you see the lake on the right turn right at the big round and follow "ingresso Sud N.7" the second round on the right there is the parking area. Park the car enter the gates, turn right and see the cablepark.

from the West:

Follow "Tangenziale Est- Linate" the same direction as it is described above.

By Railway

There is a railwaystation in Milano Centrale (mainstation) www.trenitalia.it
Take the yellow underground direction San Donato. From San Donato take a cab to the cable (5 km) Or take the bus/shuttle to Milano Linate, then take bus 73 direction San Felice and stop at the "amusement park" then walk in the idroscalo park for 3 km, or take a cab.

By plane

If you fly with Ryanair that flies to Milano Orio al Serio, you have to take the bus/shuttle to Milano Centrale that stops in the mainstation, then follow direction above described in Railway.

If you arrive in Milano Malpensa you have to take the bus/shuttle to Milano that stops in the mainstation, then follow direction above described in Railway. Or take the shuttle directly to Milano Linate. If you rent a car follow direction Milano, then follow "Tangenziale Est- Linate" and follow direction described at point by car.

If you arrive in Milano Linate take bus 73 direction San Felice and stop at the "amusement park" then walk in the idroscalo park for 3 km, or take a cab.

Course

The Cable in Milan is a Rixen system built in 1999, about 810 m long. We have a course with in the moment eight obstacles. In the moment it starts with a Uprail on the left side and taxitable on the right side. Followed by a wallride on the left. After the obstacles you have still enough space to do an inverted trick before the first corner, between the first corner and the driving tower (about 50m) there are no obstacles, you are able to do a fast invert on the left or an big one on the right.

About 80m after the driving tower there is an A-frame on the right side and a small kicker on the left. Then on the left and on the right side there are two big kickers. We also have a rail at the right side at the end of the course.
