1. LOCATION

1.1 Cables Ski Logan - Australia

Cable Ski Logan is Brisbane's only cable park, located half way between Brisbane and the Gold Coast, Australia. The park opened its doors for business as host of the IWSF World Cable Wakeboarding Titles in 2003.

Cable Ski Logan offers a unique watersport experience to young and old. Beginner to Advanced can have fun and a sense of achievement through a well designed and safe activity. Various equipment is provided, ranging from beginners kneeboards and skis to more advanced wakeboards for the extreme wakeboarder.

Located just off the Pacific motorway half way between Brisbane and the Gold Coast, the park is near many of Queensland's major tourist attractions. Just a 20 minute drive south brings you to Australia's best theme parks, while in Brisbane city you have your choice of restaurants, bars, clubs and a variety of other entertainment. Easily accessible by car, the Cable Ski Park is on the main route to the Gold Coast's Beaches and Surfers Paradise. Cable Ski Logan is south of Brisbane's CBD, 48 km from the domestic and international airport and easily accessed via the Gateway & Pacific motorway.

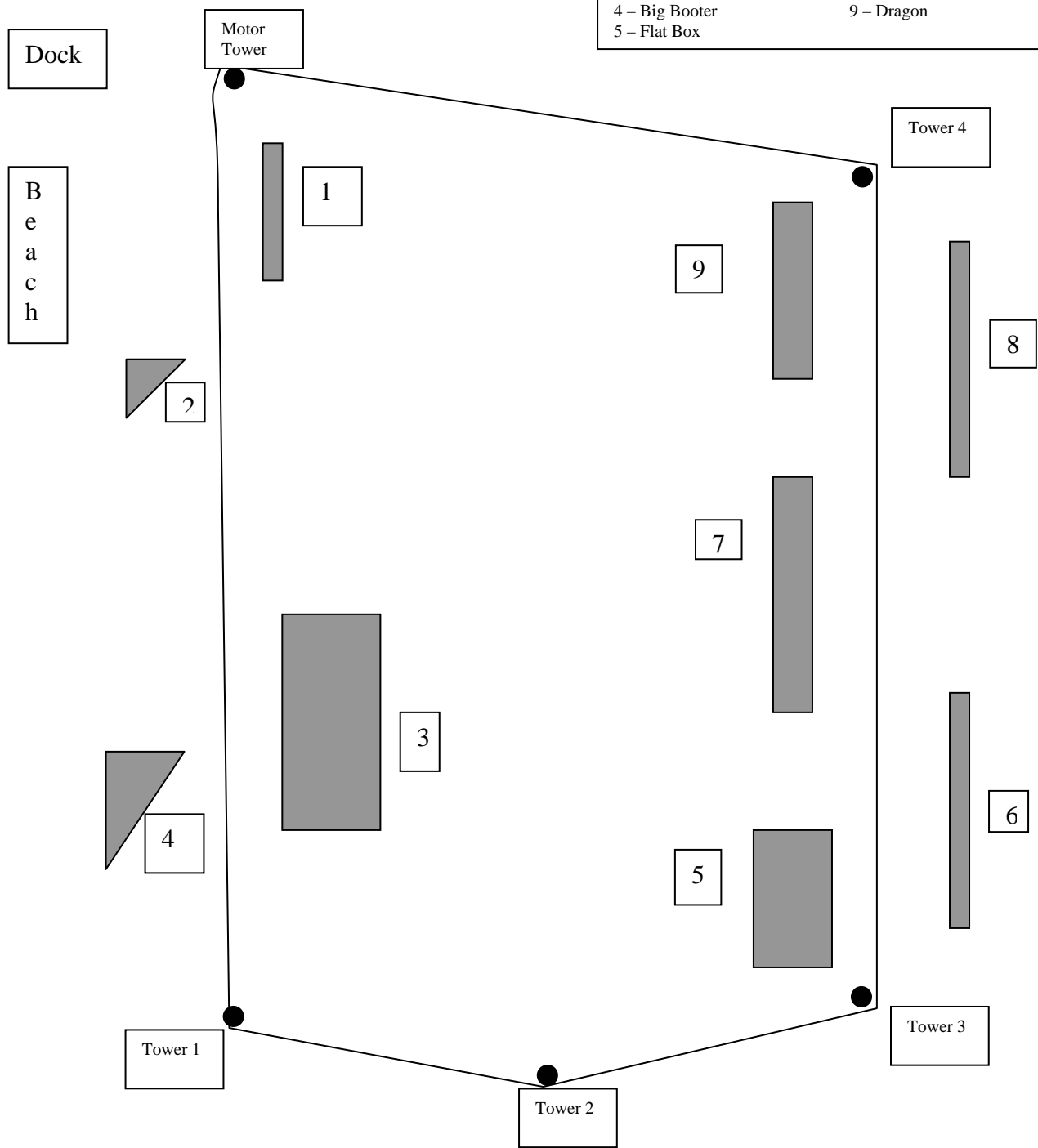

2. HOW TO GET TO CARBROOK/ BRISBANE ACCOMMODATION

2.1 FLIGHTS FROM SYDNEY TO BRISBANE

You can find Cheap Flights from Sydney to Brisbane on www.webjet.com.au with either Jetstar, Virgin, Tigar or Qantas airlines. Flights will cost approx \$45 including checked luggage (30 Euro) following the competition in Penrith Sydney from Monday 2 May - Tuesday 3rd May. Flights from Cairns will cost approx \$109 (73 Euro) to Brisbane after the Cairns ProAm stop.

2.2 Airport Transfers

Translink

Airtrain runs every 30 minutes from the Airport to Roma Street Station Transport Centre. From the Roma Street Station you can catch a train or bus to the Logan area. Trains are the Beenleigh or Gold Coast line, stopping at Beenleigh Train station. From Roma Street Transport centre catch Bus 66 to QSBS and then swap to the 555 to Logan Hyperdome. From the Logan Hyperdome a taxi costs \$20-\$25 direct to the park.
