For the E&A Championships (European Championships) Riders also need to be officially registered by their respective national federation.

This is the 3<sup>rd</sup> bulletin for the Europeans in Belgrade, with all necessary information, which we haven't published in bulletins 1 and 2. For a full overview, please refer to the previous bulletins.

## Registration

Registration will open at 3pm on Monday at the cable.

- Hotel bills - All teams must pay their hotel bills in cash on arrival (Euros or Dinars) if they have not already paid by bank transfer. These payments can be made at the registration office at the cable.
- Lycras – All competitors must pay a 30 Euro deposit at registration for their competitor's lycra. This money will be refunded on return of the lycra.
- Riders starting in both wakeboard and wakeskate category will pay the additional entry fee for second category of 50 Euro for Open and 30 Eur for Juniors
- Rider's Passes – Riders will receive their passes on completion of registration.

There will be six types of passes: Rider, Official, Team Support, Friend, Press, VIP

The Team Support and Friend's passes will cost 60 euros and include shuttles and meals and access to the restricted area on competition days (Thursday to Saturday).

The team support pass can be obtained only for the team captain and the team coach and allows access to the starting area for any heat where your riders are competing.

## Riders Representative

It is time for the E&A Cable Wakeboard Council to welcome the new riders' representative on board.

The mission of the riders' representative is to represent the views of the riders and make their voice heard within the Council.

The term of the riders' representative is until the E&A Champs in two years.

Although it is not a case with the Council members elected by E&A Congress, the riders' representative will have access to a budget to cover his/her expenses for meeting attendance to a certain extent.

## Procedure

The election of the riders' representative will take place during the riders meeting.

Only the riders competing at these European Championships and present at the riders meeting have the right to vote.

Any rider wishing to stand for the position will nominate him/herself at the time of registration. The nominees must:

- be over the age of 18
- have competed in the finals of at least two titled events in the past 4 years
- be present at the EC at the time of registrations and the riders meeting, but not necessarily as a competitor



After the registrations are closed on Wednesday evening, the list of nominees will be published on info boards at the cable, in the official hotel and at [cablewakeboard.net](http://cablewakeboard.net).

The ballot paper will be handed out to all riders participating at the Championships and the riders meeting and must be submitted by the end of the rider's meeting to the ballot box.

The results will be announced at the Opening Ceremony.

### **Training times**

The team training hours are fully booked from 9 -12 and 17 - 20 on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday.

In agreement with cable management, three more hours per day will be available on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday for individual trainings, for 10 Eur per rider / hour.

Each Federation can book one hour per rider per day (including their team training). After this date any remaining training slots will be opened up to all competitors on a first come first served basis.

### **Shuttles**

The bus is available for free to anyone with a competition pass. Please allow 30 minutes to get to the cable from the hotel.

The full shuttle schedule will be published at the hotel and at the cable at info desks.

There is a taxi rank outside the hotel, which will take you to the cable for an average cost of 6 euros.

### **Mosquitoes**

Although the number of mosquitoes in Belgrade is unusually low this year we still recommend that you bring repellent as it can get particularly bad in the evenings. There will be repellent available for purchase at the cable shop.
