



Liability: Rider - Agreement for Wakeboard Competitions

To ensure that the event runs smoothly, I acknowledge the following obligations with my signature. The obligations of the rider are a part of the admission requirements for the participants of the competition.

The Organizer does not undertake any liability for damage to persons, material or property against competitors, Technical Officials (TO), judges, official helpers and the other persons.

All competitors take part at their own risk in every respect even if they are engaged out of the competition, e.g. in any additional program. With the entry of the competition they give up any claim from cases of loss of any kind arising indirectly or directly during event. Participants ought to have effected a private accident insurance. Damage to a third party (e.g. spectators) is insured only within the limits of the organizers 'liability.

- 1. I know the official wakeboard regulations (cableway) and I agree to comply with them.
- 2. I am obliged to comply with the instructions of the competition management. I transfer all my rights to use any audio or visual materials which are recorded during the event to the organiser. The organiser has the right to use my name, my biography, etc. in connection with the particular press, promotional and advertising purposes.
- 3. I agree to attend events that are directly connected with the event and to take part in the rider meeting before the qualifications and/or the main Heat of the race.
- 4. I agree to stick to the warming up times and the official starting time. I accept that I am disqualified if I turn up more than 3 minutes late. The Jetty Marschall's instructions must be followed.
- 5. I confirm that I am not worried about my health concerning participation in the EM and that I am taking part in the event at my own risk. The participant does not have the right to claim any compensation for injuries from the EAME or the ID+MA.
- 6. I confirm that I have informed myself about the regulations on drug-taking.
- 7. I agree to take part in the award ceremony if I come $1^{st} 5^{th}$ in the competition. If I fail to do so, I will lose my right to claim any monetary, medals or other prizes.
- 8. Apart from the prizes, I will not make any other demands on the organiser of the event.
- 9. I will accept disqualification (also after the competition) if I do not follow the rider obligations or if I break the sporting fairness rules.
- 10. I agree not to make any changes to the official competition Boarder-Lycra (starting number) and to wear it during the whole competition, the award ceremony and the interviews.
- 11. I agree to take full responsibility for paying tax on the prize money.

- 12. I agree to hand in the Lycra (starting number, bib), which I will have received on registration by paying a deposit, to the competition office when all of my duties have been completed. I know, that if I want to keep the Lycra, I can keep it and don't get back the deposit.
- 13. I agree to register me at the day before official training in the Race office. I will bring my passport the starting fee and check out that my riderprofile and liability is filled out and signed. If I am not able to come, I will send someone to pay the entry fee and to choose my start categorie. I agree not to take part at the competition, if I or someone don't register me at the day before official training.
