The Hot Sport Seepark is located 3 km south of Marburg, which is in the middle of Germany and about 80 km north of Frankfurt (Airport).

Rules: The Marburg Open is a part of coordinated competitions. The competition will be carried out according to the rules of the EAME and Cable Wakeboard World Council. The competition will be carried out in freeride rules!

Facility: 10mm cableway (5 mast system), 8 carriers, length 580 m, a special rixen cableway for wakeboarding, 10 meters high, 17,80 m ropes

Prize money: Marburg Open is a (DC) Competition with 400 Ranking Points for the first place. There will be no Prizemoney at this stop, but about \$20000 for the overall CWWC rankings.

Categories: All Wakeboard Categories and all Wakeskate Categories where 3 riders entered the comp!

15 € For Saturday Evening "Drink aus die Strandbar" Party Start: After Prize Giving Ceremony till,... late.... all drinks are empty.
30,- Deposit for Lycra (don´t forget!!)
EAME federation members must have the Region EAME International Wakeboard License 2009. Riders from outside EAME must have a written permission or a license from their national federation to take part.

Registration: The competition will be carried out registered. Riders with EAME Wakeboard License will get points for the World Cable Wakeboard Ranking List. German Riders will also get points for the national ranking.

Description of the route to the Cablepark:

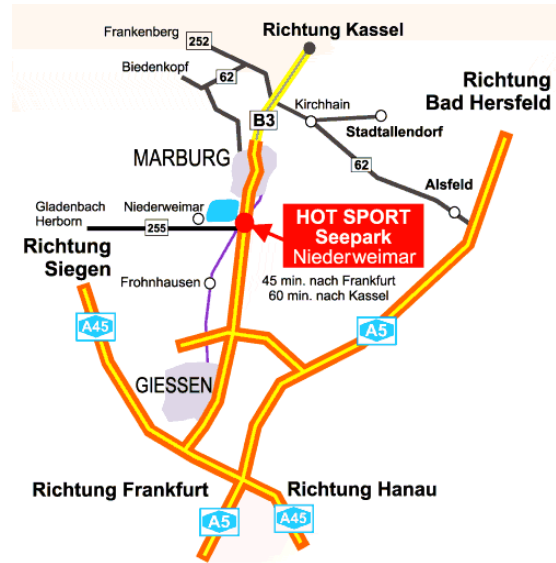
By car

from the South (Frankfurt):

Motorway A5, at the Gambacher Kreuz change to A45 direction Giessen/ Siegen and at the Giessen Süd Kreuz change to the B 3 to Marburg. About 3 km south of Marburg there is a traffic light and sand hills on the left. Turn left at the light and make a right turn after 400m. Follow the sign "Seepark".

from the North:

Motorway A5 drive down the Gambacher Kreuz. Follow the same direction as it is described above. (it is the fastest)



By Railway

There is a railwaystation about 300m away from the cablepark!

From the South:

From the Giessen Hbf (mainstation), take the RB to Treysa, leave the train at the station Niederweimar.

From the North:

From the Marburg Hbf (mainstation), take the RB to Giessen, leave the train at the station Niederweimar.

Course

The Cable in Marburg is a Rixen system built in 1999, about 580 m long. We'll have a course with in the moment seven to eight obstacles In the moment it starts with a Funbox on the right side and slider on the left side. Followed by a slider on the left and kicker on the ride side. After the obstacles you have still enough space to do an inverted trick before the first corner, between the first corner and the driving tower (about 65m) there are no obstacles, you are able to do a fast invert on the left or an big one on the right. About 80m after the driving tower there is a small Kicker on the right side. On the left side their will be also a Kicker followed from a slider box. Perhaps we also will have a big Funbox at the right side at the end of the course.

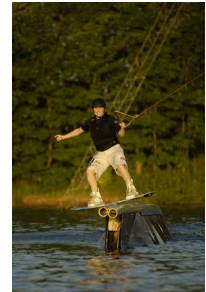

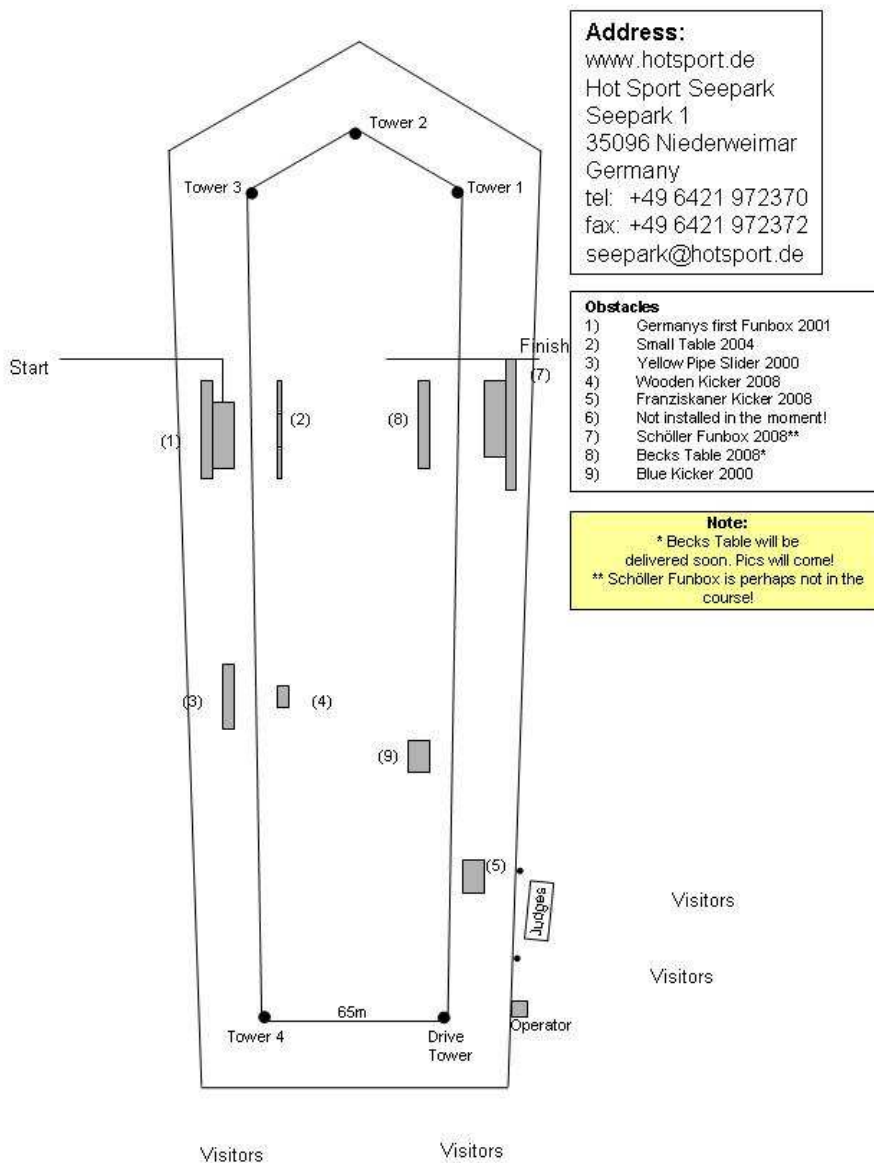
