Ukkohalla is located 649 km north of Helsinki, and 89km from Kajaani (Airport) 219km from Oulu (Airport)

Rules

The CWWC Tour 2009 by IWSF is a coordinated series of competitions. The competition will be carried out according to the rules of the EAME Cable Wakeboard Council. The competition format is free ride. Riders with IWSF wakeboard license will get points for CWWC rankings 2009.

The cable built by Rixen in 2008, is 785 meters long, with 4 pylons

Homologation

The competition will be carried out homologated. All Riders with IWSF Wakeboard License will get points for CWWC Rankings 2009 for competition type (C) international 2 event

Entry

All Competitors should enter online at www.cablewakeboard.net before the start of the competition. If you do not have an existing rider profile please make one and complete your details and upload recent photos. This information will be displayed during the competition on the screens.

Entry fee is €60 payable in euro cash on site at Registration from 29 July.

No entry minimum is required.

Riders from all over the world are invited to take part and everyone should have the IWSF International Wakeboard License 2009. If you don't have the license or don't know how to get one, please contact varna@cablewakeboard.net and we'll help you figure it out.

It is up to the organizer to invite additional riders to take part, such as local riders or snowboarders, local heroes, guests.

Accommodation

All Competitors must arrange their own accommodation.

The Ukkohalla Village offers lovely apartment houses only a few steps from the cable. The houses come in 3 sizes and different categories of quality. The price includes bedding and a final cleaning. Prices range from 25 – 35 Euro / per night/per person depending on what size and quality you need.

How to get there

The nearest Airport is Kajaani which is about 90 km from Ukkohalla. Most likely you will have to change flights in Helsinki. For more information visit: http://www.finavia.fi/airport_kajaani

From Kajaani Airport you can either travel by bus, taxi, rental car or train to Ukkohalla. If you are coming for the European Cable Wakeboard & Wakeskate Championships there will be organized bus transportation from Kajaani to Ukkohalla before the start of the championships. If you arrive later then a taxi will cost about 25 Euro per person. If you decide to rent a car please consult your travel agency or car rental agency for further information.

The second nearest Airport is Oulu which is about 220 km from Ukkohalla. Travel by taxi, car or train.
