## **Finland is getting ready for the European Cablewakeboard Championships 2009.**

**Tomorrow on thursday the green light for the Wakeboarder's 11th European Championships is going to be given. From then on about 100 riders from all over Europe will populate the wakepark in Ukohalla. It is always nice to watch the elite, which will consist of 12 nations, get together for a festival full of action and fun. The guild of wakeboarders spreads tons of lifestyle and the pure lust for life - which is really contagious and intoxicating.**

To represent top notch wakeboarding, riders not only need to have perfect body control and sophisticated technical skills but also a perfectly shaped body in peak condition to perform the formidable tricks.

There is something truly remarkable about this weekend: Besides the European Championship there will be two more competitions. For the first time in history the wakeskaters, a pretty young branch of this amazing watersport, are having their own European Championships. They will definitely amaze the masses with incredible technical tricks and virtuosic board control.

As if this wouldn't be enough, the second CWWC World Tour Stop of this season will encourage riders to gain important points for the CWWC World Ranking which will be rewarded in the end of the season at the Sukay Park World Cup in Turkey. On Sunday after the Europeans all Junior and Open categories - the first league of wakeboarding - will fight for fame, cash and glory.

With the exception of the flying Dutchman Marcel Doorgeest, the entire top ten of the current world ranking is competing in Finland. In addition to that there are some pretty hot shooting stars who made their way up from the Juniors last year and are going to battle with the more experienced riders. Everyone is looking forward for a weekend full of wakeboarding on world class level and





people from all over the world will follow this event live on the web. The Finals will be streamed live on Web TV all over the world.

A total of eight cameras will capture spectacular tricks and captivating emotions to ensure an exciting evening with memorable moments. Besides the official media partner Freecaster the action will be broadcasted worldwide on several sport and lifestyle channels all over the web. Altogether more than 900.000 million households have the chance to see excellent wakeboarding live from Finland.

On Saturday from 18:00 the finals of the European Championships can be watched and on Sunday the stream will even start one hour earlier at 17:00 and deliver the finals of the CWWC Tour Stop. In addition, action sport fans can look forward for the finest selection of hightlights from that weekend provided afterwards. The audience at location and at home will be accompanied by the "Voice of Wakeboarding" himself, Mr. Clint Liddy from Australia. He will be supported by the two Finnish colleagues Juha Halme and Tom Hannelius.
