Individual Organizers Requirements: Page 1 of 1

<u>Costs for the Organizer of an European or</u> World Cable Wakeboard Tour Stops (ECWT/ WCWT) :

- 1. Registration fee of 200,- Euro
- 2. No Sanction Fees, No Cash Prize Levy!
- 3. Overall prize money for the Tour: 25,- Euro per participating Rider, with a minimum of 600,-Euro and a maximum of 1500,- Euro.
- 4. 600,- Euro Performance guarantee (is given back to the Organizer if the competition is completed successfully or can be set against the Overall Prize Money at the comp)
- Local Prize Money for the own tourstop is up to the organizer: Minimum is 2500,- Euro Starting fee is up to the organizer and should be around 30-50 Euro. If the prize money is more than 2500,- Organizer is allowed to take more Entry fee. For each 500,- Euro more Prize Money per category the organizer can take 3,- Euro more Starting Fees in the regarding category.
- 6. Council will organize together with the Organizer, the Judging panel for the event. Council will organize one International 1 chief judge. The other two international judges can come from the home country or region but must be approved by the council. For a successful contest, we also need one scorer for immediate result scoring and one official for running the sport part of the event. For smaller events official and scorer can be the same person. Organizer has to pay all travel costs for all judges, scorers and officials. Judges and Scorers are paid 100,- Euro/ day of competition or per weekend (depending on number of competitors and length of competition).

EAME or IWSF Officials will do all the work before and at the competition voluntary according to the Olympic Spirit and Statutes.

7. Organizer has to try to make as much commercial and presswork as possible. Organizer has to collect as many as possible media results and send it to the council.

Advantages

- Council will run the sporting part of the event in conjunction with the Organizer (schedules, results, running orders, starting- and result lists, prize giving ceremony, prize money distribution, protests, ...)
- Organizer has all rights for the regional production and distribution of all promotion- and commercial materials. Organizer has to use the official logos provided by the council on all materials.
- Organizer has all rights for media and presswork also including the TV Rights
- Ranking Points will be included and updated at the EAME Ranking List after each competition
- Council will do immediate results during the competition and runs on the internet at cablewakeboard.net and on the onsite screens provided by the organizer:
- Council will organize the Judges, Scorers and Official.
- Competition is officially in EAME calendar on EAME.BE
- <u>All national Federations worldwide are able to support riders financially to take part in the</u> competition!
- Free choice of format!
- Competition advertising and promotion before, during and after the event including press releases on cablewakeboard.net, eame.be, eame.iwsf.com and iwsf.com
- Council will create the Bulletin with all competition information's and will distribute it to the riders worldwide and to the media contacts!
- Council will in conjunction with the organizer complete the registration of the riders.
