Qualification Timeframes:

Because of Media and PR Reasons there has to be a qualification deadline. Most of the Athletes (World Champion, Confederation Champion and Selected Starters) have to be invited two month before the event. National Champions, World Ranking Places 1-x have to be invited also two month before the event. Within 4 Weeks before the Event it is up to the Cable Waekboard Commission to activate riders who are available, get visa and are ready to travel in such a short notice over long distances. Therefore Equality in numbers of riders between confederations, availability of riders and placement in the ranking list is very important.
