The Course:

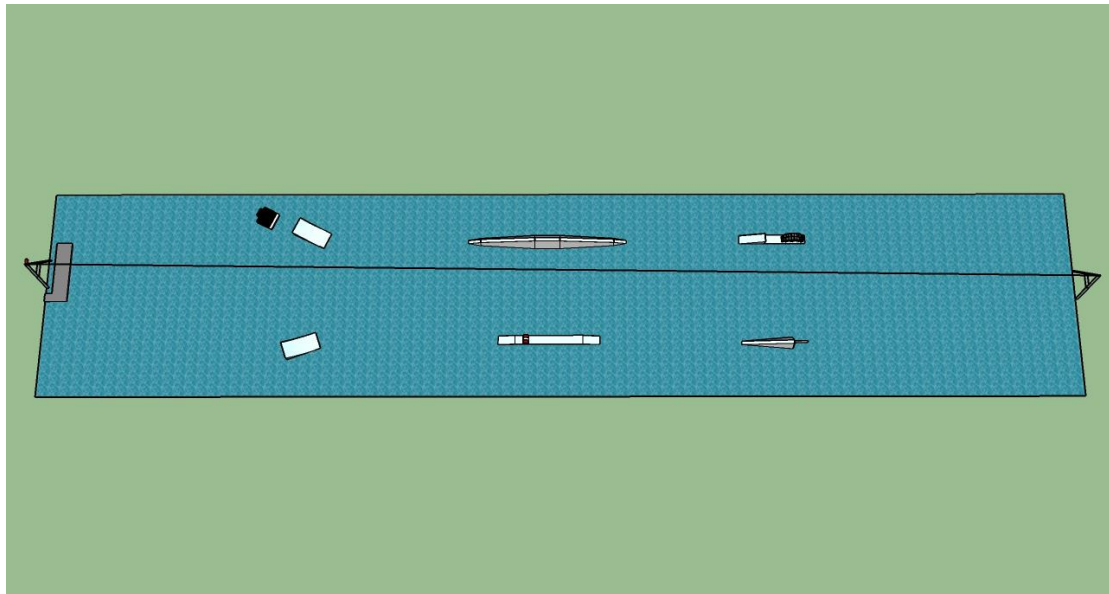

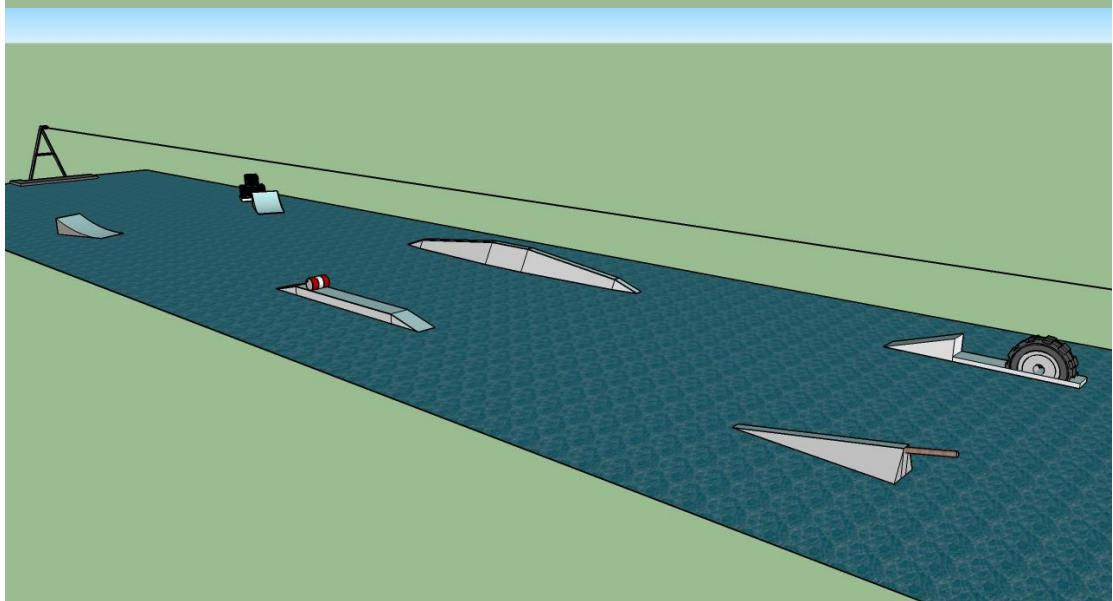
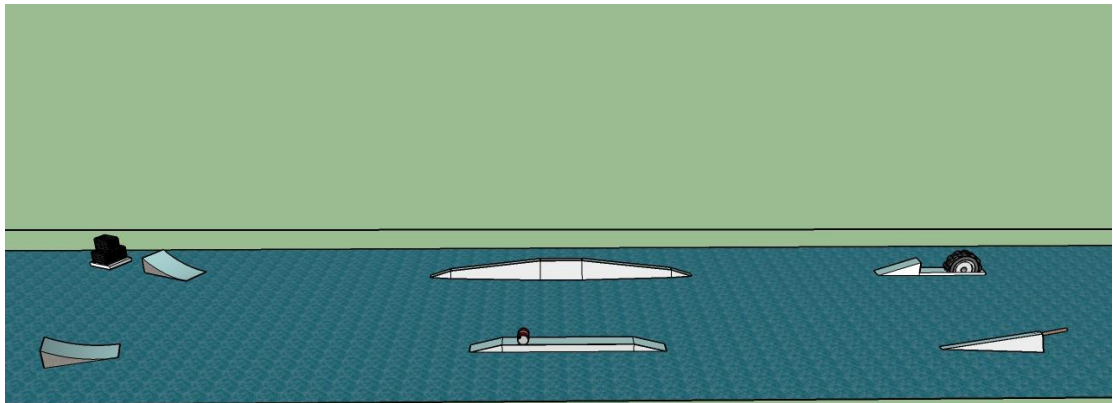
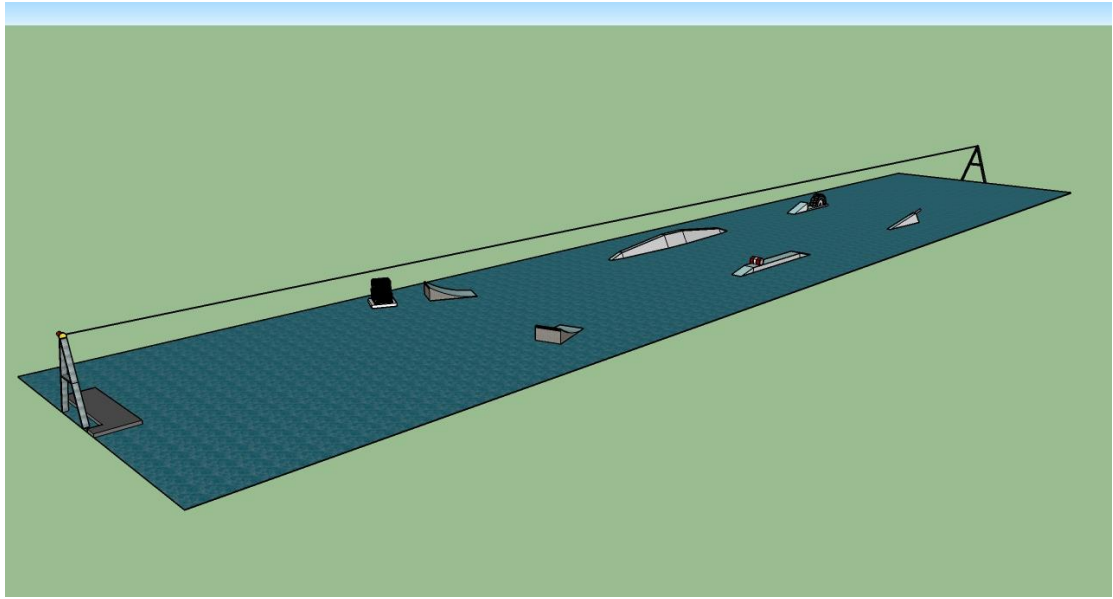
The course will be a mix of the existing Foxlake features and some bespoke features designed specially for this event.

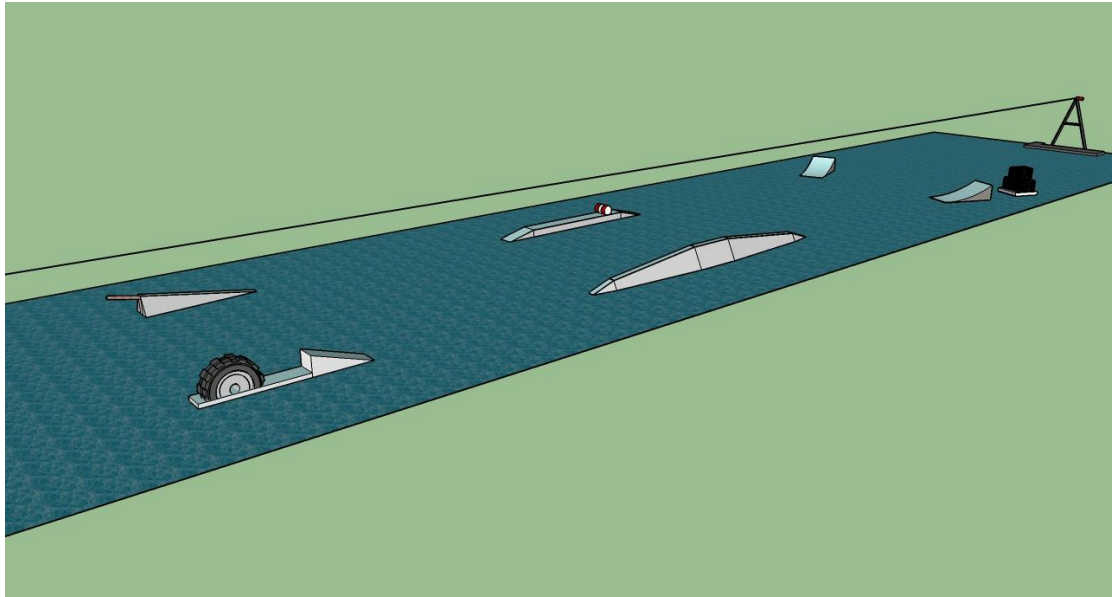
Due to the event only hosting the Open Men category, the course will be challenging, unique and aimed only for advanced / open men riders.

Features Include:

1. Industry Wake Parks Large Kicker
2. Industry Wake Parks Large Kicker to Farm Crates Gap
3. Industry Wake Parks A Frame, 76' long
4. Industry Wake Parks 48' Box with Oil Barrel Jib
5. Industry Wake Parks 24' Incline to Steel Pole Jib
6. Incline to Tractor Tyre Jib, bespoke feature built for event.







Competition Format:

No Air Tricks

Features only competition

Heats of 2 riders, 1 rider advances

Qualifying rounds will be run to select 16 riders

Once we have 16 riders, this is when the head to head format starts

Format for qualifying rounds will be decided once all entries are in

In each heat, a rider gets 2 passes of the lake, with 1 pickup
