#### 1. Location

Milan is the second most populous city in Italy after Rome.



#### 7. How to Reach the Hotels and Site

Idroscalo is located close to Linate Airport, the closest entrance to the cablepark is the south entrance via Bruno Buozzi, Peschiera Borromeo, all the north Italian Highways will bring you to Milano tangenziale, follow Linate airport sign and then the Linate scalo merci signs and you'll find the parking on the right.

Officials Hotels will provide free scheduled shuttle service from Linate airport.

Organizer will provide shuttles (4-5 persons) services from Malpensa airport 177€ and Orio al Serio €151 including VAT.

Organizer will provide shuttle service from hotels to competition site.

The weather in Milan in August is very warm. Temperatures range between 25 °C (63 °F) and 34 °C (91 °F). High humidity. 35% chance of rain.

All member Federations have to submit their Entry Form for the 2017 IWWF Europe and Africa Cable Wakeboard & Wakeskate Championships on line via the IWWF E&A Cablewakeboard Council: www.cablewakeboard.net. The link will be published on the competition page.

For <u>ANY LATE ENTRY FORM</u> registration (after the deadline of 12<sup>th</sup> July 2018), <u>€ 10 per rider</u> per day will be charged as penalty in respect of the IWWF E&A Federation rules.

**PLEASE NOTE:** ALL JUNIOR & SENIOR RIDERS HAVE TO BE ON THE COMPETITION SITE ON 11th AUGUST IN THE MORNING TO REGISTER ON TIME AND PRESENT THE PASSPORTS FOR NATIONALITY AND AGE VERIFICATION. ALL OPEN RIDERS HAVE TO BE ON THE COMPETITION SITE ON 16th AUGUST IN THE MORNING TO REGISTER ON TIME AND PRESENT THE PASSPORTS FOR NATIONALITY AND AGE VERIFICATION.

#### **14. NOMINATION FOR IWWF E&A CHAMPIONSHIPS**

Each National Federation selects its team and decides on allowing individual entries. If you are not sure of how it works in your country or how to find the nearest club or federation, please contact <u>office@cablewakeboard</u>.net and we will provide information for you.

Exceptions: Riders from countries that don't have a Wakeboard/Waterski Federation affiliated to IWWF are allowed to register for the Championships themselves. Please contact us and we will help you to arrange the insurance policy and permission for individual entry.

In addition to your official nomination and entry done by Federations, every rider needs to register and join the competition at www.cablewakeboard.net individually.

#### 15. LIABILITY

The organizer Committee and IWWF E&A will not be liable for any loss or damage to equipment or personal property, and injuries to athletes, officials, judges, official volunteers, and other persons attending official or unofficial programmers during the event. Athletes are required to purchase and show proof of personal accident insurance prior to entry. The insurance policy must provide coverage internationally.

The organizer will not be responsible for any injury sustained, at any time, by any athlete from his participation in these events.

Any costs incurred for medical treatment and hospitalization in Italy are high. Adequate personal medical insurance coverage is necessary. Certificate of medical insurance coverage/full payment is required before medical treatment/hospitalization takes place.

All riders have to sign a liability form, and riders under 18 need their parents to sign as well. Each Team Captain has to give Liability forms of all his athletes at the Registration. Liability form is ready for download at: **CWWC liability form / CWWC liability form - under 18** 

#### **16. DOPING CONTROL**

In accordance with the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules, drug controls will be conducted during the competitions. In entering this competition, all athletes agree to be subject to doping control.

All riders must have their passports with them at any time during the competition. Please note, if you are randomly chosen for drug testing, and fail to identify yourself with your passport, or fail to take the test for any other reason, it will result with an immediate disqualification.

Each Team Captain has to give all Anti-doping forms of all his athletes at the Registration.

#### **17. OFFICIAL TEAM TRAINING & EXTRA RENTAL HOURS PER COUNTRY**

Official training for teams is on August, 12th August. As always, each country will have the training times calculated by number of riders. The final schedule by country will be published on August, 11th in the evening (after the registrations are done).

Federations can also book rental hours for teams online on 8-10th August from 7 to 11 and 14 to 17 hours. For the rental hours, we will follow these rules:

- Each country has 6 credits to book 6 different time frames.
- Each time frame is 30 minutes and has no limit of entries.
- You can use all 6 credits on Wednesday, but only 4 on Thursday and 2 on Friday.
- The deadline for booking is 6pm on the day before 13 hours before the first time frame of the next day start.
- Any booking will be open to all the riders from this country.
- Price for 30 minutes is 100 €, divided by number of riders in each time frame and charged to Federations accordingly.
- We kindly ask you to make the payment at the registration on site for your number of riders and time used.

Federations can also book rental hours for teams from 10 to 12 during weekdays from April to competition day.

#### 17. OFFICIALS' SEMINAR

There will be an international Officials' Seminar from 9th till 11th August. It's possible to take part at the competition and the Seminar.

The seminar takes 2,5 days and includes lunches and coffee breaks from Sunday till Tuesday.
