**Cable:** Rixen 4-tower System, height about 10 meters

**Obstacles:** Kicker small outside, Double Roof Top with Pipe and wallride inside, straight box outside

Official registrations are finished on Wednesday, 10<sup>th</sup> of July 2019 at 24.00h.

All registrations after this date are late registrations and are only possible until Saturday, 13<sup>th</sup> of May 2019 at 18:00 h (6:00 pm) local time.

## **Categories:**

### Wakeboard

- Mini-Kids Boys / Girls Wakeboard (under 11), no international ranking points!
- Boys / Girls: born in 2004 or later (under 15)
- Junior Men / Junior Ladies: born in 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003 (under 19)
- Open Ladies / Open Men: no age restrictions
- Masters Men: born in 1988 or before (over 30)
- Veterans Men: 1978 (over 40)

### Wakeskate

- Open class, no age restrictions

(In case there are less than 3 competitors in one category the category will be mixed with the superior one - according to the agreement of the ChiefJudge)

## **Entry fee:**

Open Men, Open Ladies, Masters, Veterans, Wakeskate: 35,- Euro

Mini Boys, Mini Girls, Boys, Girls, Junior Men, Junior Ladies: 30,- Euro

Late registration: 45,- Euro

The entry fee also includes the official training!

## How to get there:

### Public transport

If you use the public transport you best go by train to the main stations in the city center. Then take the Underground U2 and leave the train at Station "Donaustadtbrücke". Use the back end exit of the station. Then turn right and after 300 Meter you reach the cable park.

### By car

Coming from west, south and east use the A23 city highway - Exit "Ölhafen Lobau"

Coming from the north us the A22 highway. Also take the Exit "Ölhafen Lobau"

Turn left at the first traffic light and follow the street back till you see the signs for "WakeUp" or Underground. For parking use the park & ride garage on the right hand side.

With the parking ticket for about € 3,40 you can stay there the whole day.

Pleas note: You need to buy a "Vignette" for using the Austrian highways!


Speed limits: city: 50 km/h, country road: 100 km/h, highway: 130 km/h

### By plane

"Vienna Schwechat international airport" is about 15 minutes away from the cable park.

You can use the CAT (city airport train) and then change to the underground.

As an alternative you can fly to Bratislava (Slovakia), about one hour from Vienna.



## LIABILITY (English)

The organizer does not take over adhesion for persons -, special or financial damages opposite fighters, arbitrators, official ones, aids or third persons. All fighters participate in each relationship on own danger, even if they engage themselves outside of the match, e.g. in the master program. With the participation the runners do without any demands of requirements from all cases of damage, which result directly or indirectly from the meeting. All participants must be liability-insured accident - and/or. The requirements of the condition and the safety precautions of the match distances depend on the valid in each case regulations of the international water ski and wakeboard federation (IWWF) region Europe & Africa (E&A), the national water ski and wakeboard federation (OEWVV), the valid in each case regulation and delivering mode of the OEWVV and the valid in each case agreement (product requirement specifications) between the organizing committee (OK ONE) and the OEWVV, whereby the arrangements of the respective arbitrator are determining. Each participant commits itself to speak own objections the arbitrator. With his start the fighter gives to recognize that the given condition of the match distance and existing safety precautions are suitable as and are sufficiently recognized. An adhesion for a certain condition of the match distance or certain safety precautions, going beyond that, does not take over the organizer. All athletes get the adhesion explanation during the registration suburb to the signature submitted.

## **HAFTUNG (Liability in German)**

Der Veranstalter übernimmt keine Haftung für Personen-, Sach- oder Vermögensschäden gegenüber Wettkämpfern, Schiedsrichtern, Offiziellen, Helfern oder dritten Personen. Alle Wettkämpfer nehmen in jeder Beziehung auf eigene Gefahr teil, auch wenn sie sich außerhalb des Wettkampfes engagieren, z. B. im Rahmenprogramm. Mit der Teilnahme verzichten die Läufer auf jegliche Forderungen von Ansprüchen aus allen Schadensfällen, die direkt oder indirekt durch die Veranstaltung entstehen. Alle Teilnehmer müssen Unfall - bzw. Haftpflichtversichert sein.

Die Anforderungen an den Zustand und die Sicherheitsmaßnahmen der Wettkampfstrecken richten sich nach den jeweils gültigen Bestimmungen des Internationalen Wasserski und Wakeboard Verbandes (IWWF) Region EA, des Nationalen Wasserski und Wakeboard Verbandes (ÖWWV), dem jeweils gültigen Reglement und Austragungsmodus des ÖWWV und der jeweils gültigen Vereinbarung (Pflichtenheft) zwischen dem Organisationskomitee (OK) und dem ÖWWV, wobei die Anordnungen des jeweiligen Schiedsrichters maßgebend sind. Jeder Teilnehmer verpflichtet sich, eigene Bemängelungen dem Schiedsrichter vorzutragen. Mit seinem Start gibt der Wettkämpfer zu erkennen, dass der gegebene Zustand der Wettkampfstrecke und die vorhandenen Sicherheitsvorkehrungen als geeignet und ausreichend anerkannt werden. Eine darüberhinausgehende Haftung für einen bestimmten Zustand der Wettkampfstrecke oder bestimmte Sicherheitsvorkehrungen übernimmt der Veranstalter nicht. Alle Athleten bekommen die Haftungserklärung bei der Anmeldung vor Ort vorgelegt und müssen diese unterschreiben.
