RULES

The competition will be run in line with the current published World Cable Wakeboard and Wakeskate discipline rule book.

PLEASE BE AWARE THIS COMPETITION IS FOR THE **OPEN CATEGORIES ONLY**

AGE RESTRICTIONS

Only riders aged 11yrs + are eligible to ride in the Championships, which means all riders must have reached at least their 11th Birthday by 26th June 2024. There is no upper age limit for the category.

RANKING POINTS

Minimum Ranking points required for OPEN Riders are 800 Ranking Points for Wakeboard and Wakeskate. There are no Minimum Point Requirements for SEATED Riders.

Additionally, each federation can enter a maximum of two additional riders per category with no minimum points required (these are called Wildcards). The host federation also receives a total of two additional wildcards that can be used across the categories.

A rider can only use one Wildcard per competition, so cannot enter both Wakeboard and Wakeskate without minimum points – they must hold the minimum 800 points in at least one of the disciplines.

It is NOT possible to merge points from other AGE Categories for the OPEN competition. Riders must hold the points within the OPEN Category.

ENTRY AND ADMINISTRATION

ENTRY FEE PER ATHLETE: €280

Entry must be made by your federation on cablewakeboard.net and payment should be made via Bank Transfer by your FEDERATION for the WHOLE TEAM – NO individual payments should be made.

The federation making the payment are liable for all the fees relevant to the transfer and the amount to be received by the IWWF Cable Wakeboard Council is to be the exact amount of the entry. If any entry has bank charges deducted on receipt into the account, the federation will be asked to make up the shortfall at Registration.

Payments on site will only be accepted for Team Training, which is only calculated once all the riders are fully registered.

ENTRY DEADLINE

Entries must be confirmed by the Federations on Cablewakeboard.net no later than:

Friday 24th May 2024.

Late Entry Fees apply from 00:00 (CET) on **Saturday 25th May 2024** and is calculated at **€10** per athlete per day that they have not been ticked as approved by the federation on Cablewakeboard.net

Federations: Please ensure you understand the process for approving team athletes before this deadline, as late entry fees will apply if you have not contacted us in advance. Contacting us on the deadline will not waive the late entry fee.

For RIDERS from countries without a Federation: Please contact the IWWF Cable Wakeboard Council well in advance so that we can explain the process for entry. In some cases, Double Entry Fees may apply, but there are also limits to the number of riders allowed to complete.

PAYMENT FOR ENTRIES DEADLINE

Payment for Team Entries must be made by **FRIDAY 31st MAY 2024**

FEDERATIONS not making payment by this date will incur a LATE PAYMENT FEE of €500

Athletes will not be able to compete until the late payment fee has been paid. Payment must be made for all athletes that have been marked as approved by the federation. If athletes are not able to compete after being approved, then the federation must contact the Technical Delegate of the competition at the earliest opportunity. Fees will only be returned under exceptional circumstances and accompanied by the relevant documentation. Federations may be granted the ability to change

the rider for a replacement rider if the reason is due to injury. This change can be without additional late entry fees from the point the initial rider was approved.

REGISTRATION:

RIDERS - Before the Event:

- You need to be member of your national federation and have their licence.
- Register on www.cablewakeboard.net BEFORE 20th May 2024 - Register yourself for the championship.
- Ask your federation to approve you for that event. BEFORE 24th MAY 2024
- Make sure you pack your passport, and have it available on site during the competition, and give it to your team captain for registration.
- Remember to buy your personal accident insurance and ensure it covers you to compete at the event.

At the Event:

Registration will happen on Wednesday 26th & Thursday 27th JUNE 2024.

- Team Captains will be given a time slot for their team registration. If they miss this time slot, then they will have to wait until the registration team are ready to process them. Teams that are ready at their given time slot will be given priority for registration.
- The Team Captain is responsible for registering the WHOLE team, there is no individual registration process.
- If the Team Captain is missing a rider's information, then they will have to wait until the last team are registered to complete their registration. If documents are missing, then the rider will not be able to compete, and no refunds will be made for entry fees paid.
- The Team Captain will need to collect all Riders Passports and Insurance Documents prior to registration
- The Team Captain will produce all the passports to the Registration team, who will check DOB's and Nationalities against the passports.
- The registration Team will also ask to see the athlete's personal accident insurance and check an indemnity form has been completed (waiver)
 - Once the Insurance/passports & waivers have been checked, the registration team and Chief Scorer will check that the athletes either have the required points for competing or the team are within the allowance for wildcards.

OPEN WAKEBOARD & WAKESKATE – Require 800 Ranking Points

OPEN SEATED RIDERS – Do NOT Require Ranking Points

The registration team will also ask to see proof of payment for the team, so please bring a copy of the bank transfer. For any teams that decide to wait to transfer the team entry please be aware that the transfer amount will need to include the late payment fee of **€500**.

Team Training will need to be paid during registration, this will have been calculated by the Chief Scorer and should be paid on site in Cash (€ or £ GBP) It is not possible to provide this information earlier, as we do not know until 24hrs prior to training how many riders will be on each session.

- Team Training can only be booked by the Team Captain or authorised Federation Member on Cablewakeboard.net.
- Paid on site at Registration. More than one team can share the slot and share the cost.
- Teams are allowed to book a maximum of 6 - 30 minute slots.

OFFICIAL TRAINING

THURSDAY 27th JUNE 2024

As always, each country will have the training times calculated by number of riders. The final schedule by country will be published on cablewakeboard.net in the evening after the registrations are done.

Please give the Registration team and scorers time to finish registration and allocate times properly.

They have a lot to check and want to make sure everything is accurate.

Training on the official practice day is included in the entry fees.

DOPING CONTROL

For DOPING Controls, you need to have an International valid passport.

In line with the IWWF Doping Rules, Doping controls will be conducted during the competition.

By entering this competition, all athletes agree to be subject to doping control.

Please be aware that to travel to the United Kingdom from Europe or Africa you must be in receipt of a valid passport.

SAFE SPORT

Please be aware of the IWWF Safe Sport Guidelines.

The IWWF believes that all athletes, staff, and volunteers have the right to participate and develop in sport, in a safe and inclusive environment, free from all forms of discrimination, abuse, violence, neglect and exploitation. For young people, these rights are paramount.

The IWWF is committed to devising and implementing policies to ensure that everyone within the broader remit of the organisation accepts their responsibility to attempt to safeguard athletes and participants from harm and abuse by following procedures designed to safeguard them and reporting any concerns about their welfare through established pathways.

The Cable was brand new in 2021 and hosted the UK Cable Nationals in 2023.

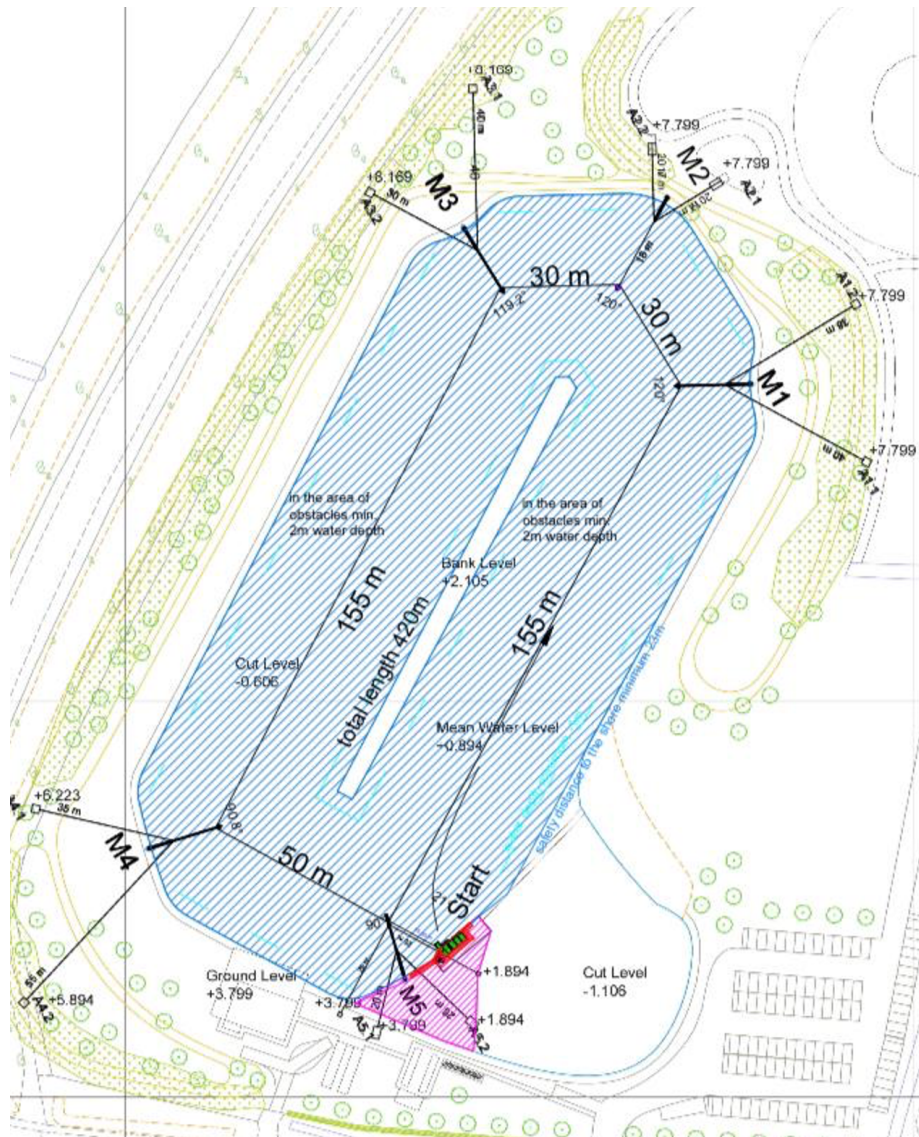
