2 Before travelling to Germany

2.1 Visa

“European Community passport holders do not need a visa to visit Germany. Many other nationals are also exempt for stays of up to 3 months, however, if in doubt we advise you to check before travelling. All visa information for Germany is available on the website of the German Embassy.”

2.2 Identity Card

Before travelling to Germany you need to have a current identity card if you are in the European Community otherwise you need a passport.

2.3 Further entry requirements

Advice for travelling by car:

1. blood alcohol limit while driving a car:
 - a. people under the age of 21 are prohibited to have any blood alcohol limit
 - b. all the other people are *allowed* to have a blood alcohol limit of 0,3 per mill, but you can still get into trouble, please don't drink and drive

2. speed limit:
 - a. city limit 50km/h if not marked otherwise
 - b. country road 100km/h if not marked otherwise
 - c. Autobahn no limit if not marked otherwise

If you will arrive by plane:

If you will travel by train:

Take the interurban train (U5 towards Neuperlach Süd) from Munich main train station to Innsbrucker Ring. At Innsbrucker Ring station change into U2 towards Messestadt Ost. Get off at Messestadt West. From there you have to walk to the bus station Messestadt West. At that bus station get on the bus 263 towards Heimstetten, Nord. Your final destination will be Aschheim, Erdinger Street.
