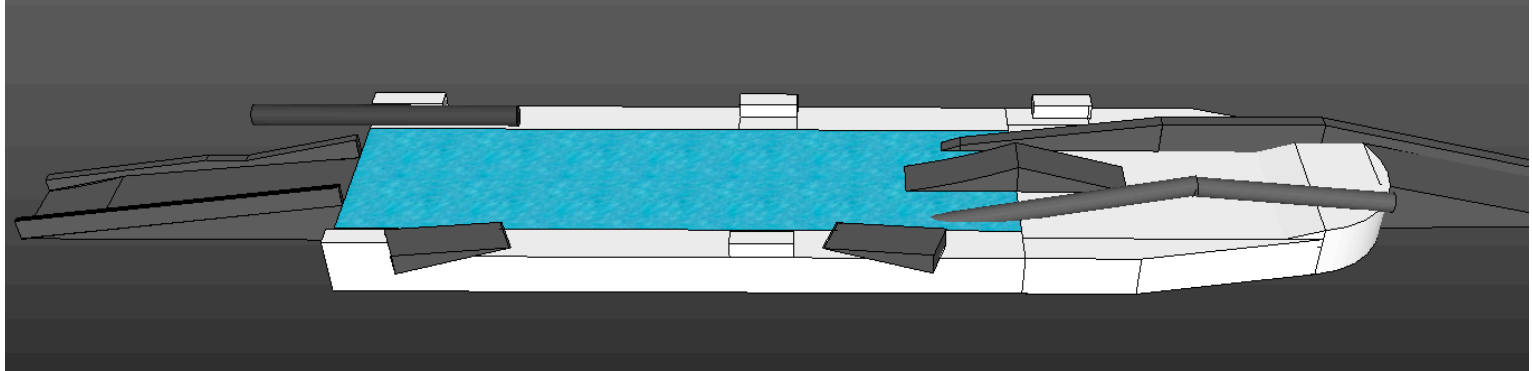

This year the **Wake Parade** is open for everyone, the best 2 riders will get a wildcard for the Red Bull Wake Of Steel on 16.June 2012 in LINZ (AUT) at the industry harbour. At the Red Bull Wake Of Steel there will be a unique 60m long steel ship with multiple rail, pipe, box, pool and kicker variations. 16 riders (12 invited + 4 wildcards) will fight head to head on a System 2.0, for cashprizes. Red Bull Wake of Steel will be combined with a music festival.



### Location

The Salmsee in Steyregg is located 10 minutes from LINZ, the capital city of upper Austria. LINZ has a population of 200.000 inhabitants and is very famous for his strong economy but it also has a very pleasant city center and nightlife. 2009 LINZ was Europe's culture capital city. A must see is the ARS Museum of the Future.



**The Salmsee** consists of two man-made lakes, specially made for waterskiing. Founded 30 years ago by the MYCN (Motor Yard Club Nibelungen) big waterski events like world championships, etc... have already been held on the Salmsee. Since 2008 Daniel "Fetzy" Fetz has rented one of the Salmsee lakes for his wakeboard school, where he is runs a wakeboard boat plus a two-tower cable. Wake Parade will be the first wakeboard event ever held on the Salmsee.

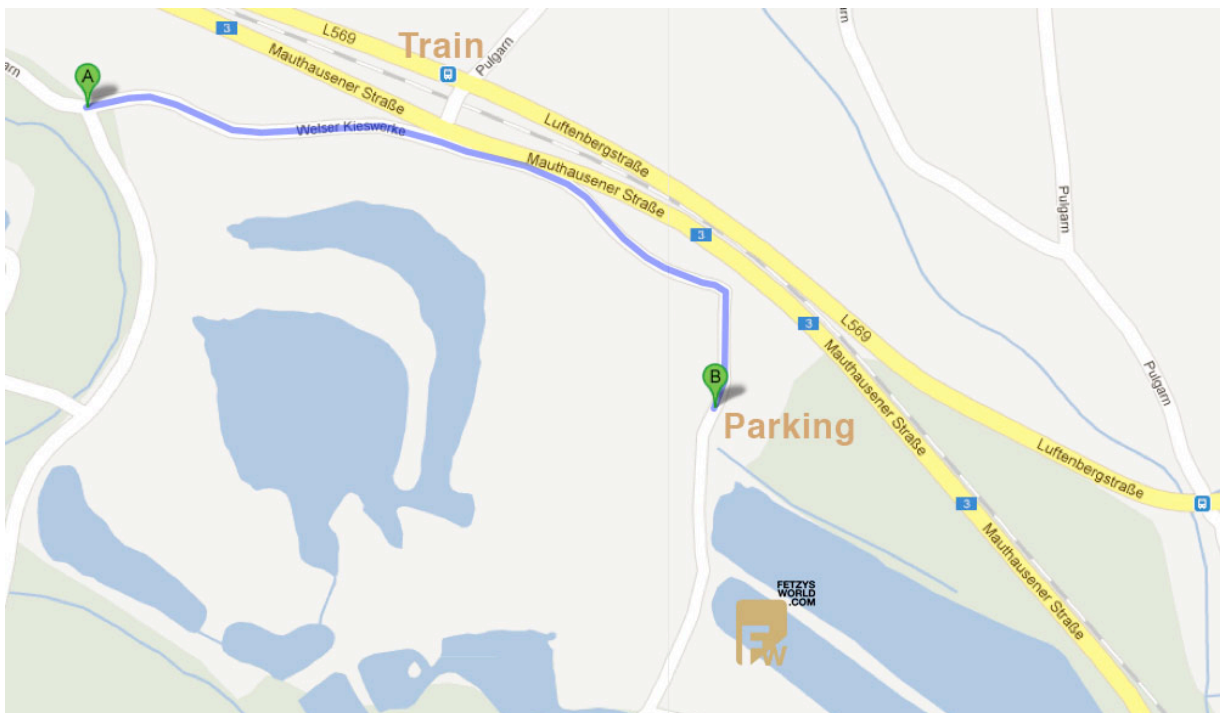
### How to get there

**By car:** Unfortunately the Salmsee has no official street name for your navigation system. The GPS coordinates are: N 48.274325 E 14.398484 The closest official street is: "Welser Kieswerke 1, Steyregg" (Marked with A on the map)

In Google maps, you can enter "fetzysworld" and it will bring you almost there, just the last 200m are not tracked, but you just have to keep going straight until you see the parking

space and the white swing gate. The last 100m you have to walk over to the second lake to the right.

**By plane:** The Vienna airport is about 2 hours drive and Munich 3 hours by car. The closest airport is Linz Hörsching, which is about 20 min drive by car/Taxi. For all other airports we recommend the SMS Airport Shuttle Service. For example the price from Munich to Linz with SMS both ways is 100 €. **By train:** Steyregg has its own train station, just 2 stations away from Linz Hbf (the main train station in Linz). From there all hotels in Steyregg are in walking distance. Salmsee also has its own train station called „Pulgarn“ which is one station away from Steyregg. From Pulgarn it's a 5 minute walk to Salmsee. You have to cross the big road (B3 - Mauthausner Straße) and turn left, follow the sign MYCN. You can book your train tickets at [www.oebb.at](http://www.oebb.at)

Obstacle only format: The best trick on kicker and slider will be added up.

## Categories:

Open Men & Open Women: No age restriction  
Junior Men & Junior Women: Age see E&A rules  
Boys & Girls: Age see E&A rules  
Masters: Age see E&A rules

## Prizes

The top 3 places from each category will get a trophy.

The top 5 places from each category will get non-cash-prizes (clothes, equipment,...)

The top 4 places from the **overall obstacle performance of the whole day, from all categories** will share **1000 € Price money**, see split below.

The top 2 places of the **overall obstacle performance** will get a wildcard for the Red Bull Wake Of Steel. For e.g.: if a Junior Men rider will land a double backroll on the kicker in the qualification and a super stylish slider trick in the final, he can also win a wildcard.

1 <sup>st</sup> place	400 € + Wildcard
2 <sup>nd</sup> place	300 € + Wildcard
3 <sup>rd</sup> place	200 €
4 <sup>th</sup> place	100 €

## Entry Fee:

The entry fee is 45 € per Person and must be paid cash on-site at the registration until Friday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2012 19:00 local time.

**10 Euros Late Entry Fee** for registration after 28th May 2012 20:00.

## Timetable

Registration on site: Thursday evening and Friday  
Free Training: All day Friday and Saturday morning.  
Competition: Saturday

Detailed Timetable will be published in Bulletin No 2 a view days before the competition.

Parallel to the training, it's also possible to book the wakeboard boat for wakesurfing or hit the wake or check out the big A-frame slider. To guaranty some free space it's suggested to book the boat early enough in advance.

## License

All riders should be members of their respective country's IWWF affiliated Federation with a valid international wakeboard license.

If you are not sure how it works in your country, how to find the nearest club or the federation contact, please contact us and we'll provide information for you.

## Exceptions

Riders from countries that don't have a Wakeboard/Waterski Federation affiliated to IWWF can register for the competition. If this is the case please contact us and we'll help you to arrange the insurance policy and permission for individual entry.

## Athletes Registration

On-site registration will be on Thursday 31 May from 15:00 – 19:00 local time and Friday

1st June from 9:00 – 19:00 local time. Please bring along your passport or ID in order to identify yourself. **No** registration on Saturday.

### **Doping control**

In accordance with the IWWF Anti-Doping Policy, random drug testing may be conducted on any of the competition days. All riders must have their passports with them at all times during the competition. Please note, if you are randomly chosen for drug testing, and fail to identify yourself with your passport, or fail to take the test for any other reason, it will result with an immediate disqualification. IWWF complies with WADA Anti-Doping Policy. Please visit [www.wada-ama.org](http://www.wada-ama.org) for more information on prohibited substances and TUE.
