# BULLETIN 2 (includes all info from Bulletin 1 and updates)

The 16<sup>th</sup> E&A Cable Wakeboard & Wakeskate Championships 2014 are held in Ostroda, Poland. The city of Ostroda is situated in northern part of Poland, in halfway between Warsaw and Gdansk. This relatively small but fast growing city is focusing its promotion on tourism and sport.



The cablepark's lake is located almost in the city center. There is a boulevard around the lake with a lot of restaurants, hotels and some recreational facilities. There is no need for shuttle buses because all we need for the championships is already on site.

Beside the championships, there are lots of activities such as concerts and the "festival of fire" during "Ostroda Summer Hot Days".

#### **Currency**

PL (Polish Zloty) is used in Poland and all major credit cards are accepted almost everywhere. In most places Euro is also accepted but the exchange rates are poor. ## **Travel**

**FREDERIC CHOPIN AIRPORT (WAW)** is the main airport in Poland and it is located 210 km from the tournament site. Shuttle service for up to 7 people from WAW to Ostroda: €110 One-way and €220 Round-trip.

WARSAW MODLIN AIRPORT (WMI) is a smaller airport located 170 km from Ostroda. It's the best choice if you wish to choose a flight for a reasonable price. Shuttle service for up to 7 people from WAW to Ostroda: €100 One-way and €200 Round-trip.

These are the prices per shuttle. The organizer will communicate to make sure shuttles are filled up as much as possible to keep the cost down.

For shuttle service, contact wake@acroboard.pl with time of arrival and flight number.

Please note that all riders have to be on site on July 14<sup>th</sup> in the morning to register on time and present their <u>passports</u> for nationality and age verification.

Cable in Ostroda was built in 2007 and has a four tower Rixen system. The cable is 800m long and 10m high. The tow lines are 20m long.





#### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

#### **Nomination**

It is the sole responsibility of IWWF-affiliated National Federations to select and enter their riders.

Please have the new Entry Requirements in mind: CWWC Rulebook §3.2

**MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS AS OF YEAR 2014** will be 800 points for U19, Open and Over 30, and 400 points for all other categories on the rolling CWWC Ranking list the day the competition starts. Additionally, each Federation can enter max. 2 riders per gender per category with no minimum requirements.

The minimum amount of points can be reached by adding points from different categories. For example, a rider U15 competes in U19 category at a 4 STAR Events and in U15 category at his Nationals championships. He can start in his Confederation Championship in U15 category if the total reaches 400 points, or in higher categories if his total reaches 800 points...

## **Registration**

2. In cash at the site before the competition starts. Cash payment can be done in Euros or Polish ZL. Currency conversion from Euros will be done that day.

## **Entry fee and registration on site**

Entry fees are set by IWWF Europe and are as follows: €180 Open/Master €140 Juniors/Youngsters

Please kindly note that your entry fee includes, starting pack, bib and soft drinks from the day of the Official training till Saturday. Other drinks and food are not included, but can be purchased at the cable park. Entry fee also includes free entry to the final riders Party!

Again, entry fees must be paid through wire transfer (no later than July 5<sup>th</sup>) or in cash at the site on Monday July 14<sup>th</sup>. Please refer to the schedule for the registration times.

## Official team training & rental hours for teams

Official training for teams is on Tuesday, 15<sup>th</sup> July. As always, each country will have the training times calculated by number of riders. The final schedule by country will be published on Monday, 14<sup>th</sup> in the evening (after the registrations are done).

Federations can book rental hours for teams online for Saturday, Sunday and Monday, 12-14<sup>th</sup> July from 7 to 12 and 16 to 20 hours. For rental hours we will follow these rules:

- Each country has 6 credits to book 6 different time frames.
- Each time frame is 30 minutes and has no limit of entries.
- You can use all 6 credits on Saturday, but only 4 on Sunday and 2 on Monday.
- The deadline for booking is 13 hours before the first time frame of the next day start.
- You can only book with your full team of entered riders.
- Price for 30 minutes is 50 €, divided by number of riders in each time frame and charged to Federations accordingly.
- We kindly ask you to make the payment at the registration on site for your number of riders and time used.

## Lunch

Lunch will be available at the site for a cost of €6 for riders and the public. Lunch tickets will be available for purchase in the race office.

### **Nomination for E&A Championships**

Each National Federation selects its team and decides to allow individual entries. If you are not sure of how it works in your country or how to find the nearest club or federation, please contact <a href="mailto:office@cablewakeboard.net">office@cablewakeboard.net</a> and we will provide information for you.

Exceptions: Riders from countries that don't have a Wakeboard/Waterski Federation affiliated to IWWF are allowed to register for the Championships themselves. Please contact us and we will help you to arrange the insurance policy and permission for individual entry.

#### How it works?

The International Waterski and Wakeboard Federation (IWWF) was founded in 1946. IWWF is recognized by the International Olympic Committee (IOC) as official partner since 1967. Wakeboarding is part of the World Games (Non Olympic Games patronized by IOC) since 2005. The IWWF is the world leader in waterskiing and wakeboarding with more than 90 member nations, hundreds of clubs and thousands of members. Together with agencies and local federations, the IWWF organizes Nationals Championships, European and World Championships, the IWWF World Cup and World Trophy, and hundreds of internationals competitions all over the world.

The IWWF Cable Wakeboard World Council (CWWC) is a rider formed, voluntary non-profit working council. CWWC organizes and promotes wakeboard, helping organizers to create and run competitions, developing the Cable Wakeboard World Rules, formats, judging criteria's and educating judges. The CWWC is recognized for running the sport part of events under fair conditions for all riders, fair and fast judging, perfect "just in time" timetables, live & online results, and results interfaces for live streaming or live TV Productions. #### **Doping control**

In accordance with the IWWF Anti-Doping Policy, random drug testing will be conducted on any of the competition days. All riders must have their passports with them at any time during the competition. Please note, if you are randomly chosen for drug testing, and fail to identify yourself with your passport, or fail to take the test for any other reason, it will result with an immediate disqualification. IWWF complies with WADA Anti-Doping Policy. Please visit <a href="www.wada-ama.org">www.wada-ama.org</a> for more information on prohibited substances and TUE.

Riders must carry their passport at all time during the competition for the doping control.
